****FALL TERM 2004 REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS****

Course selections must be made in consultation with faculty advisors. The 2003-04 Academic Register gives full descriptions of courses as well as information on prerequisites. Additional course descriptions may be found within this document. Courses with numbers 1-9 generally do not carry academic credit. Courses numbered 10-99 are designed primarily for undergraduates with limited experience in the discipline. Courses numbered 100-199 are designed for undergraduates with a foundation of experience in the discipline.

WRITTEN PERMISSION from your advisor is required and must be submitted to the Office of the Registrar when taking less than the normal course load (three (3) courses) per term. Please see Page 2 for information regarding fourth courses.

Please Note: Union College and The Graduate College of Union University are two separate Colleges. All graduate level courses taken by Union undergraduates, including Leadership in Medicine and Combined Degree students will be taken through the Graduate College of Union University and will require completion of a special "Graduate College of Union University" Cross Registration Form. These forms are available in the Registrar's Office in Silliman Hall.

DISCLOSURE OF DIRECTORY INFORMATION: Union College hereby designates the following student information as public or "Directory Information." Such information may be disclosed by the institution for any purpose, at its discretion:

Name, address (campus, home, e-mail), telephone numbers, date and place of birth, academic fields of study, dates of attendance, ID photographs, participation in recognized activities and sports, degrees and awards, weight and height of athletic team members, most previous educational agency or institution attended, or other similar information. The College may publicize or respond to requests for such information at its discretion. However the use of these records for commercial or political purposes is prohibited unless approved by the Vice President for Academic Affairs.

Currently enrolled students may withhold disclosure of this information under the Family Educational Rights & Privacy Act of 1974, as amended. To withhold disclosure, written notification must be received in the Office of the Dean of Students no later than the fifth day of each new term. Forms requesting the withholding of "Directory Information" are available in the Office of the Dean of Students.

Union College assumes that failure on the part of any student to specifically request the withholding of "Directory Information" indicate individual approval for disclosure. Furthermore, pursuant to the terms of the Family Educational Rights & Privacy Act of 1974, as amended, Union College reserves the right to publish or release any or all of the above "Directory Information" for internal institutional use only, whether or not a student requests the withholding of such information by the means indicated above.

Fourth Course Policy (Effective Fall Term 2004)

The annual tuition at Union allows a student to register for three terms taking three courses per term. This allows students to complete the required 36 courses for graduation. In some Engineering programs as many as 40 courses may be required and those students are permitted to enroll in 10 courses per year. Under certain circumstances students may be allowed to take a fourth course in a term.

Students who are making satisfactory progress in their program of study are allowed to enroll in **one** fourth course during an academic year at no extra charge, provided they have a **GPA of at least 3.3**. These courses can be used to enhance the student's academic experience at Union, as can any additional fourth courses, for which there will be a fee. All such courses will appear on the transcript and can be used to fulfill program requirements; **however, they can not be used for the purposes of accelerated graduation. (This includes fourth courses taken on a Term Abroad.)**

Fourth courses can also be used to make up a deficiency in credits due to withdrawals or failure or if a student does not have the requisite GPA. A fourth course fee will be charged under these circumstances (for 2004-2005 the fee will be approximately \$2276).

All students will be required to fill out the "Petition to Enroll in a Fourth Course" form and to obtain the Dean of Undergraduate Education's signature. Forms are available in the Dean's Office or the Registrar's Office.

Students will not be allowed to sign up for fourth courses until the beginning of the term. The exception is Engineering students signing up for their first fourth course of the year.

*****DESCRIPTION OF COURSES NOT IN THE 2003-2004 ACADEMIC REGISTER*****

IDM 104 – Election 2004

The objective of Election 2004 is to provide insights on the election from the perspectives of many disciplines. Approximately twenty-seven faculty members from twenty departments will participate in the course. A different faculty member(s) will teach each class. Their charge is the following: "This is not an invitation to give a political speech on your personal views, tempting as that might be. But rather, the intent is to provide an analysis of some aspect of the election based upon your discipline." Some sample lecture titles are: "The Environmental Policies of George W. Bush and John Kerry," "Israelis, Arabs and Election 2004," "The Economic Significance of Budget and Trade Deficits," "Pictures and Politics: Magazine Covers and the Candidates," "Buying the Vote in Ancient Rome," "Electronic Voting Systems: Should We Trust Them," "The Gender Gap: What Difference Will Women Voters Make?" and much more

The course is open to sophomores, juniors and seniors; fifty slots are allotted to each class. There are no prerequisites. It is not a card course. For additional information, contact Hal Fried in the Economics Department.

Performing Arts Practica – One course credit is optionally available for participation, after 3 consecutive terms, of Choir (AMUpres); Orchestra (AMUpres); Jazz Ensemble (AMUpres); Theater (ATHprct); Dance (ADAprc -- \$100.00 per term); and for vocal and instrumental lessons (AMUpres -- individual fees). SPECIAL NOTE TO ALL STUDENTS SIGNING UP FOR COURSES WHICH HAVE MULTIPLE SECTIONS, ESPECIALLY IN THE SCIENCES: Due to the possibility of over and under enrollments in

certain sections of multiple section courses, the Registrar's Office, at the request of department chairs, may switch students out of their originally scheduled courses in order to balance the sections.
