Course selections must be made in consultation with faculty advisors. The 2004-05 Academic Register gives full descriptions of courses as well as information on prerequisites. Additional course descriptions may be found within this document. Courses with numbers 1-9 generally do not carry academic credit. Courses numbered 10-99 are designed primarily for undergraduates with limited experience in the discipline. Courses numbered 100-199 are designed for undergraduates with a foundation of experience in the discipline.

**WRITTEN PERMISSION** from your advisor is required and must be submitted to the Office of the Registrar when taking less than the normal course load ( three (3) courses ) per term. Please see Page 2 for information regarding fourth courses.

**Please Note:** Union College and The Graduate College of Union University are two separate Colleges. All graduate level courses taken by Union undergraduates, including Leadership in Medicine and Combined Degree students will be taken through the Graduate College of Union University and will require completion of a special “Graduate College of Union University” Cross Registration Form. These forms are available in the Registrar’s Office in Silliman Hall.

**DISCLOSURE OF DIRECTORY INFORMATION:** Union College hereby designates the following student information as public or “Directory Information.” Such information may be disclosed by the institution for any purpose, at its discretion:

Name, address (campus, home, e-mail), telephone numbers, date and place of birth, academic fields of study, dates of attendance, ID photographs, participation in recognized activities and sports, degrees and awards, weight and height of athletic team members, most previous educational agency or institution attended, or other similar information. The College may publicize or respond to requests for such information at its discretion. However the use of these records for commercial or political purposes is prohibited unless approved by the Vice President for Academic Affairs.

Currently enrolled students may withhold disclosure of this information under the Family Educational Rights & Privacy Act of 1974, as amended. ## **Fourth Course Policy** (Effective Winter Term 2004)

The annual tuition at Union allows a student to register for three terms taking three courses per term. This allows students to complete the required 36 courses for graduation. In some Engineering programs as many as 40 courses may be required and those students are permitted to enroll in 10 courses per year. Under certain circumstances students may be allowed to take a fourth course in a term.

Students who are making satisfactory progress in their program of study are allowed to enroll in one fourth course during an academic year at no extra charge, provided they have a GPA of at least 3.3. These courses can be used to enhance the student's academic experience at Union, as can any additional fourth courses, for which there will be a fee. All such courses will appear on the transcript and can be used to fulfill program requirements; however, they can not be used for the purposes of accelerated graduation. (This includes fourth courses taken on a Term Abroad.)

Fourth courses can also be used to make up a deficiency in credits due to withdrawals or failure or if a student does not have the requisite GPA. A 4<sup>th</sup> course fee will be charged under these circumstances (for 2004-2005 the fee will be approximately \$2276). Students whose GPA is below 2.5 will need the written permission of Dean Rosenthal **before** signing up for a fourth course.

**ALL** students, with the exception of Leadership in Medicine, Union Scholars, and Seward Fellows, will be required to fill out the "Petition to Enroll in a Fourth Course" form. Forms are available at the Registrar's Office.

Students will not be allowed to sign up for fourth courses until the beginning of the term. The exception is Engineering students signing up for their first 4<sup>th</sup> course of the year.

**\*\*\* DESCRIPTIONS OF COURSES NOT IN THE  
2004-2005 ACADEMIC REGISTER \*\*\***

**ANT-068 - East Asia in Motion: People, Culture, and Identity**

East Asia has a long history of constantly shifting borders, diasporic populations, and unstable identities. Seeking to go beyond the idea of the bounded national cultures of China, Japan and Korea, this course takes East Asian as region to examine how cultural forms and people have changed as a result of contemporary and historical globalization forces both within and outside of the region. The course will cover anthropological categories such as diaspora, race, gender, identity, tourism, memory, sports, etc., but will reconsider them within the East Asian context(s).

**BIO-094 – Understanding Cancer**

The main objectives of this course are to understand some of the fundamental concepts involved in the life cycle of a cell, how cancer is related to those processes, and how those fundamental processes have led to advances in cancer treatment.

**PHL-150 - Topics in the History of Philosophy: Ludwig Wittgenstein**

This course will introduce the work of Ludwig Wittgenstein (1889-1951), one of the most influential philosophers of the twentieth century, and regarded by some as the most important since Immanuel Kant. Wittgenstein's early work culminated in the *Tractatus Logico-Philosophicus*, the only book that he published during his lifetime. It is based on the idea that philosophical problems arise from misunderstandings of the logic of language, and it tries to show what this logic is. Wittgenstein's later work, principally his *Philosophical Investigations*, shares this concern with logic and language, but takes a different, less technical, approach to philosophical problems. This book, which spawned the philosophical movement called *ordinary language* philosophy contains work on rule-following and private language that is still under discussion by contemporary philosophers. Wittgenstein's later philosophy is also influential in a growing number of fields outside philosophy.

**PHY-068 - Galaxies**

A survey of the physical properties, dynamics, and distribution of galaxies. Topics include the contents, origin, and evolution of the Milky Way and other galaxies; the large-scale distribution of galaxies; interactions between galaxies; dark matter; active galaxies and nuclear black holes; high redshift Universe. Prerequisite: Physics 16 or 18.

**PSC-087 – CIA and the Art of Intelligence**

This course provides a historical background to intelligence and espionage, and offers perspectives on present-day secret intelligence operations of world powers in support of their national security objectives. We will discuss intelligence analysis, evaluation, human and technical intelligence, cryptography, counter-intelligence, moles, and various kinds of covert operations. The course also explores U.S. foreign policy issues and goals. We will both study the evolution of intelligence ideology and organization as it fits into our national security goals, as well as how the demands of secrecy conflict with the idea of democracy and openness.
