

## **\*FALL TERM 2005 REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS\***

Course selections must be made in consultation with faculty advisors. The 2004-05 Academic Register gives full descriptions of courses as well as information on prerequisites. Additional course descriptions may be found within this document.

**Effective Fall Term 2005**, a new four level course numbering scheme will be in place. Courses numbered 0-49 will be those that carry no credit. Courses numbered 50-99 are designated for General Education or other courses that do not count for the major. Courses numbered 100-199 are all introductory level offerings. Courses numbered 200-299 are those at the sophomore/junior level that may also be taken by non-majors. Courses numbered 300-399 are upper-level which are primarily intended for majors, i.e. which represent the depth component of the major. Courses numbered 400-499 are all advanced level courses for seniors, including those used to fulfill the Senior Writing Experience (WS), seminars, research, thesis and independent studies.

**WRITTEN PERMISSION** from your advisor is required and must be submitted to the Office of the Registrar when taking less than the normal course load (three (3) courses ) per term. Please see Page 2 for information regarding fourth courses.

**DISCLOSURE OF DIRECTORY INFORMATION:** Union College hereby designates the following student information as public or "Directory Information." Such information may be disclosed by the institution for any purpose, at its discretion:

**Please Note:** Union College and The Graduate College of Union University are two separate Colleges. All graduate level courses taken by Union undergraduates, including Leadership in Medicine and Combined Degree students will be taken through the Graduate College of Union University and will require completion of a special "Graduate College of Union University" Cross Registration Form. These forms are available in the Registrar's Office in Silliman Hall.

## **Fourth Course Policy** (Effective Spring Term 2004)

The annual tuition at Union allows a student to register for three terms taking three courses per term. This allows students to complete the required 36 courses for graduation. In some Engineering programs as many as 40 courses may be required and those students are permitted to enroll in 10 courses per year. Under certain circumstances students may be allowed to take a fourth course in a term.

Students who are making satisfactory progress in their program of study are allowed to enroll in one fourth course during an academic year at no extra charge, provided they have a GPA of at least 3.3. These courses can be used to enhance the student's academic experience at Union, as can any additional fourth courses, for which there will be a fee. All such courses will appear on the transcript and can be used to fulfill program requirements; however, they can not be used for the purpose of accelerated graduation. (This includes fourth courses taken on a Term Abroad.)

Fourth courses can also be used to make up a deficiency in credits due to withdrawals or failure or if a student does not have the requisite GPA. A 4<sup>th</sup> course fee will be charged under these circumstances (for 2005-2006 the fee will be approximately \$2,445). Students whose GPA is below 2.5 will need the written permission of Dean Rosenthal before signing up for a fourth course.

All students, including engineering students, will be required to fill out the "Petition to Enroll in a Fourth Course" form. Forms are available at the Registrar's Office.

Students will not be allowed to sign up for fourth courses until the beginning of the term. The exception is Engineering students signing up for their first 4<sup>th</sup> course of the year.

**\*\*\* DESCRIPTIONS OF COURSES NOT IN THE  
2005-2006 ACADEMIC REGISTER \*\*\***

**ANT-181 – Anthropology of Sub-Saharan Africa**

This course provides a broad ethnographic survey of the peoples and cultures of the African continent. While the course seeks to show the diversity of the continent through an introduction to the fifty-four countries and hundreds of ethnic groups that constitute contemporary Africa. This course stresses the transitional and global linkages between Africa and the rest of the world and seeks to show how Africa is central to an understanding of the world. In this sense, the course looks beyond the news of Africa that focuses on tragedies such as wars, famines, and AIDS crisis, to engage everyday life in Africa.

**MLT-273 – Reviewing Spanish Cinema; From Dictators, Bullfighters and Flamenco to Nationalism and Globalization**

This course examines the works of such well known artists/filmmakers as Medem, Almodovar, Bigas Luna, de la Iglesia, Amenabar, among others, who often directly engage with questions of “Spanishness,” of the nature of regional and ethnic diversity and identities within Spain, and the place of these identities in the wider framework of filmmaking in Europe. Furthermore, it will also study popular cinema which has been successful in a national context under the Franco regime and since the coming of democracy in the 1970s. *GenEd: EUC;WAC*

**PHL-265 – Philosophy of Art**

What is art? What makes something a work of art? How does art reflect on the human condition? Can we give reasons for our judgments about art, or are they simply expressions of what we like and dislike? A philosophical approach to art takes up questions of ontology, aesthetic value, and claims to the expression of truth through artistic creation. The aim of this course is to explore these questions, among others, by examining the positions of major philosophers and twentieth-century artists. As part of the course, we will look at and reflect upon examples of contemporary painting, music, theatre, and dance.

**PHL-339 – Buddhism and the Concept of a Person (WAC)**

This course will be a fusion of traditional Buddhist philosophy and contemporary analytic personal identity theory. Special attention will be given to views according to which the self, or person, is a fictional entity. Attention will be devoted to exploring different ways to state this view precisely and to answer objections to it. The two main texts for the course will be Mark Siderits, *Buddhism and the Concept of a Person: Empty Persons* (Ashgate, 2001) and Derek Parfit, *Reasons and Persons* (Oxford University Press, 1984). Individual classes will be a combination of lecture and discussion. Probably there will be several short papers and no exams.

**PHL-367 – Skepticism**

The epistemological skeptic claims that we know very little or nothing of what we ordinarily take ourselves to know. Much of the historical and contemporary epistemological literature is either a response to or defense of this skeptical claim. The purpose of this course is to introduce you to epistemology through the topic of skepticism. We'll read philosophers by philosophers such as Descartes, Kant, Austen, Moore, Carnap, Quine, Stroud, and Putnam, in order to get a handle on some of the historical and contemporary responses to the skeptic.

**SMT-400 – Seminar: Science, Medicine & Technology**

The seminar will survey the disciplines that study science, technology, and medicine by means of classic reading in these fields. The second half of the term will be devoted to a collaborative research project on a topic that will be chosen at the beginning of the seminar.

**SPECIAL NOTE TO ALL STUDENTS SIGNING UP FOR COURSES WHICH HAVE MULTIPLE SECTIONS, ESPECIALLY IN THE SCIENCES:** Due to the possibility of over and under enrollments in certain sections of multiple section courses, the Registrar's Office, at the request of department chairs, may switch students out of their originally scheduled courses in order to balance the sections.

**ATTENTION: NOT ALL POLITICAL SCIENCE COURSES ARE CARD COURSES.** In the past **all** Political Science courses were card courses, **HOWEVER**, this is no longer the case. For fall term 2005 prescheduling, only PSC 113, PSC 277, PSC 359 and PSC 369 will be card courses. If you are interested in taking PSC 113, 277, 359 or 369 you must fill in a course preference sheet that can be obtained from the Political Science department (SSCI 105) and turn it in to the department by 4p.m. Tuesday, May 10. (For PSC 277 you must speak to Professor Zumbrunnen before filling in a course preference sheet.) You may sign up for all other PSC courses during your prescheduling appointment in the registrar's office from May 24th – May 26th. Some of these courses will be on a first come, first serve basis. Others will have a specified number of seats allocated for each class.

Please refer to the catalog description in the current Academic Register for specific course prerequisites.
