

****WINTER TERM 2006 REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS****

Course selections must be made in consultation with faculty advisors. The 2005-06 Academic Register gives full descriptions of courses as well as information on prerequisites. Additional course descriptions may be found within this document.

Effective Fall Term 2005, a new four level course numbering scheme was put in to place. Courses numbered 0-49 will be those that carry no credit. Courses numbered 50-99 are designated for General Education or other courses that do not count for the major. Courses numbered 100-199 are all introductory level offerings. Courses numbered 200-299 are those at the sophomore/junior level that may also be taken by non-majors. Courses numbered 300-399 are upper-level which are primarily intended for majors, i.e. which represent the depth component of the major. Courses numbered 400-499 are all advanced level courses for seniors, including those used to fulfill the Senior Writing Experience (WS), seminars, research, thesis and independent studies.

WRITTEN PERMISSION from your advisor is required and must be submitted to the Office of the Registrar when taking less than the normal course load (three (3) courses) per term. Please see Page 2 for information regarding fourth courses.

Please Note: Union College and The Graduate College of Union University are two separate Colleges. All graduate level courses taken by Union undergraduates, including Leadership in Medicine and Combined Degree students will be taken through the Graduate College of Union University and will require completion of a special "Graduate College of Union University" Cross Registration Form. These forms are available in the Registrar's Office in Silliman Hall.

Fourth Course Policy

The annual tuition at Union allows a student to register for three terms taking three courses per term. This allows students to complete the required 36 courses for graduation. In some Engineering programs as many as 40 courses may be required and those students are permitted to enroll in 10 courses per year.

Students who are making satisfactory progress in their program of study are allowed to enroll in one fourth course during an academic year at no extra charge, provided they have a GPA of at least 3.3. These courses can be used to enhance the student's academic experience at Union, as can any additional fourth courses, for which there will be a fee. All such courses will appear on the transcript and can be used to fulfill program requirements; however, they can not be used for the purpose of accelerated graduation. (This includes fourth courses taken on a Term Abroad.)

Fourth courses can also be used to make up a deficiency in credits due to withdrawals or failure, or if a student does not have the requisite GPA. A 4th course fee will be charged under these circumstances (for 2005-2006 the fee will be \$2,445). Students whose GPA is below 2.5 will need the written permission from Dean Rosenthal before signing up for a fourth course.

All students, except Leadership in Medicine (LIM) and Scholar students, will be required to fill out the "Petition to Enroll in a Fourth Course" form. Forms are available at the Registrar's Office or on the web.

***** DESCRIPTIONS OF COURSES NOT IN THE
2005-2006 ACADEMIC REGISTER *****

ACC 100 Survey of Accounting – A survey of selected topics within various areas of accounting such as managerial accounting, financial accounting and tax accounting. Emphasis will be on concepts and not on record keeping.

ADA 045 Tap Dance Practicum- Tap dance provides students with the study of steps found in the tap dancing art form. Students will be introduced to proper warm up, tap steps, specific exercises in rhythms, routines, and use of music. For dancers, adding a tap class will give them the opportunity to learn about a new dance form. Students that have previous experience in tap will be able to expand their expertise. For the theater students the learning of tap can eventually be useful for musicals. \$100 Fee. Please refer to the Misc. Notes on Page six (6) regarding possible credit.

ADA 150/ATH 127 Staging Explorations in Theater and Dance – Course based on the multi-disciplinary arts of the early twentieth century in France that will offer students an immersion into important developments in Western performative expressions. Will study this dynamic era of the French avant-garde, its historical background, and principal creators in theater, dance, visual arts, and cinema. This influential period will be explored through discussions and lectures, studio work, and collaborative creation. The theater/dance collaboration will be produced and performed at the Yulman Theater during the Winter Dance Concert. *No prerequisite.*

BIO 094 Understanding Cancer – Everyone has been touched at some point in their lives by cancer. This course aims to provide insight into the fundamental concepts involved in the life cycle of a cell, how cancer is related to those processes, and how those fundamental processes have led to advances in cancer. Not open to students who have already completed BIO 110 and BIO 113. Fulfills GenEd science requirement (SCIE) (no lab).

CLS 142 The Ancient World in Film and Literature – Greco-Roman antiquity has been a favorite topic of Hollywood for years. This fascination continues today with the recent appearance of the blockbusters *Troy* and *Gladiator*, as well as such TV productions as *Helen of Troy* and *Rome*. Why do the Greeks and Romans appeal to a modern audience? This course will consider ancient texts in translation alongside with their modern film representations. Our goal will not be to consider where the films went “wrong”. Instead, we will question how these films recast and reinterpret classical texts to reflect modern interests. This course will include an “entrepreneurship module.” We will question what is entrepreneurship and if Hollywood’s commodification of the ancient world is entrepreneurial. No previous knowledge is required. All texts are in English.

CSC 065 Creative Computing – An introduction to computer science and programming for everyone who never thought they could successfully tell the computer to do cool things. First we will explore the magic and limitations of computing through a number of physical exercises. Then students will use the Python programming language to do things such as robot simulations, image manipulation, sound splicing, animations, HTML generation and automated reading of web pages. This course is open to all students. GenEd: Math.

CSC 240 Web Programming – This course addresses the standards in programming applications for the Web. It will cover XHTML, CSS, JavaScript, PHP, and some CGI programming in Perl and Python. It is intended for Computer Science majors. Non-majors should consider CSC 055 – Working with the Web. Prerequisites: CSC 105 – Introduction to Computer Science

ECE 222 Introduction to Circuits and Electronics - Electrical quantities, circuit principles, analysis and response of basic circuits, semiconductor physics, diodes, transistors, and operational amplifiers. Includes a weekly lab. Not open to Electrical or Computer Engineering majors, or to students who have taken ECE225. Prerequisites: ESC100, PHY121

HST 143 Entrepreneurship in Medieval and Renaissance Europe– This course will examine the meaning and impact of entrepreneurship during the thousand years (or so) prior to the rise of modern capitalism in the early modern era. It will take a broad view of entrepreneurship as ability to perceive opportunities that others cannot see and to exploit those opportunities by combining resources and expertise to achieve a particular end. Economic entrepreneurs will get most, but not all of the attention.

MTH 052 Statistics: Mathematical Analysis of Data - An introductory course on the concepts and application of probability and the analysis of sampling of data. Topics include an introduction to probability, stochastic processes, sampling theory, linear regression, inference, confidence intervals, hypothesis testing, and comparison of samples. Not open to students who have taken a Math Course. GenEd: MATH.

MTH 197 Discrete Mathematics in Computer Science – Designed to enable the student to develop the ability to understand and communicate mathematical arguments in the context of a number of topics in discrete mathematics that are of direct relevance to computer science.

PHL 233 Philosophy of Biology – This course will take you on a tour through some of the philosophical and theoretical issues related to the biological sciences. We'll begin by examining the basic principles of evolutionary theory, and the putative challenges it faces from advocates of 'Intelligent Design'. We'll then consider a hotly debated issue *internal* to biology: the question of how best to understand the role of adaptationist reasoning in evolutionary theory. As a case study, we'll have a detailed look at the current dispute over the evolution of the language faculty. We'll then turn to some of the possible implications of evolutionary theory for the study of culture and ethics. We'll end the term by considering some practical issues that biology raises, focusing on the ethical/social issues related to the Human Genome Project, human stem cell research, and human cloning.
