

Installation and Configuration: VirusScan 8.5

VirusScan is an anti-virus program written for Mac OS X to clean and protect your computer from viruses.

DOWNLOAD

Open a web browser such as Internet Explorer or Safari and type in the location window or click the link below:

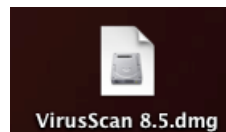

The URL will place you at a window with various downloadable software. Double-Click on VirusScan8.5.dmg. The VirusScan 8.5 installation file will be saved on your desktop.

Downloading is complete. Please go to the Installation portion of this document.

INSTALLATION

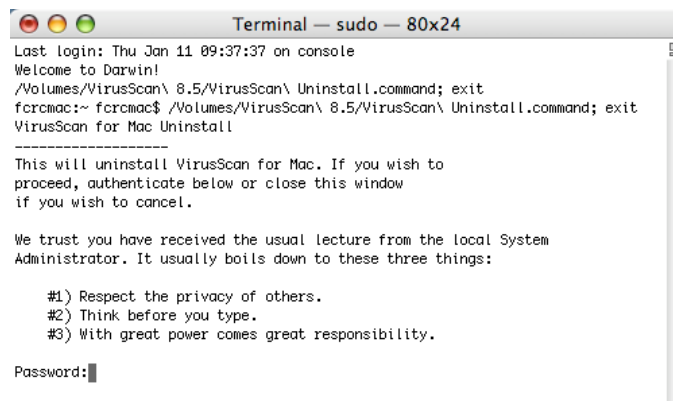
1. Double click the VirusScan 8.5.dmg icon shown below. This will extract the setup files into the VirusScan 8.5 folder.



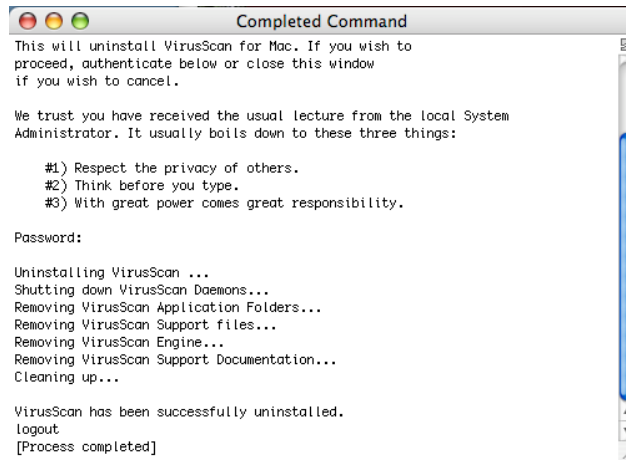
2. Double click the VirusScan 8.5 folder. If you have an older version of VirusScan installed, double click on the VirusScan Uninstall.command icon as shown below. This will begin the uninstall process.



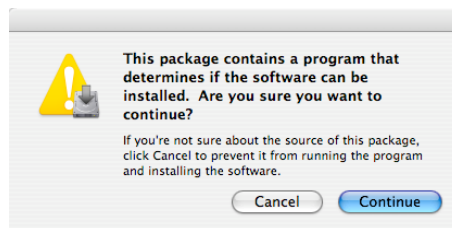
3. Enter your password to start the uninstaller.



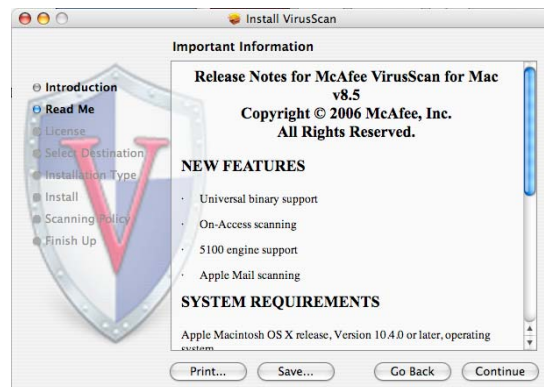
- Once the uninstaller has completed, you will see a window similar to the one below. Close this window and go back to the VirusScan 8.5 folder (screen in step 2).



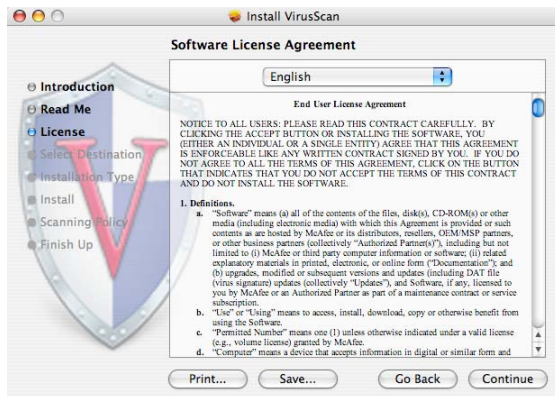
- Double click on the VirusScan.pkg icon. This will start the installation of VirusScan 8.5
- Once you begin the setup process you will see a window similar to the one below click **Continue** to continue.



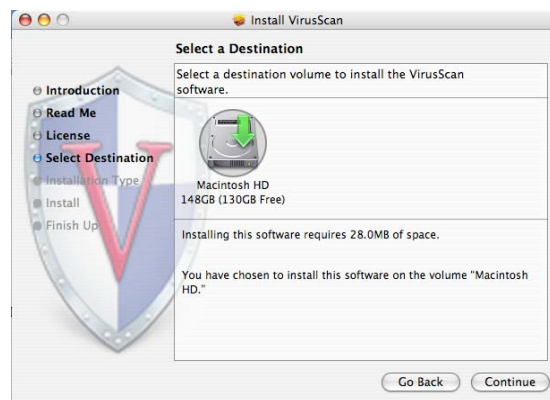
- Click **Continue** in the following two windows.



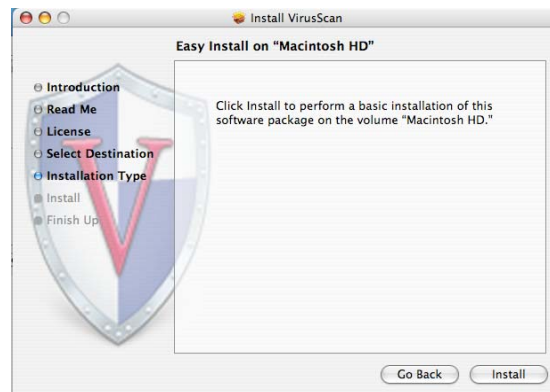
8. Read the license agreement and then click **Continue**. Once you have clicked **Continue** a popup window will appear, as shown below, asking you to agree to the license agreement. If you have read and agree to the license terms, click **Agree**.



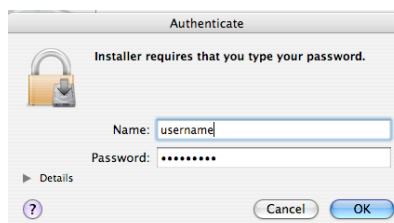
9. You will now be asked to select a destination for VirusScan 8.5. Select the Macintosh HD as shown below and click **Continue**.



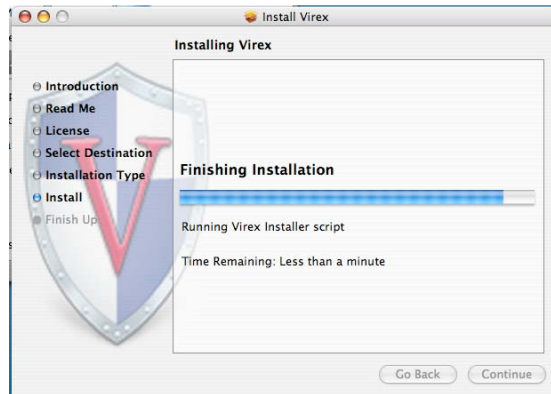
10. Click **Install** in the following window to proceed.



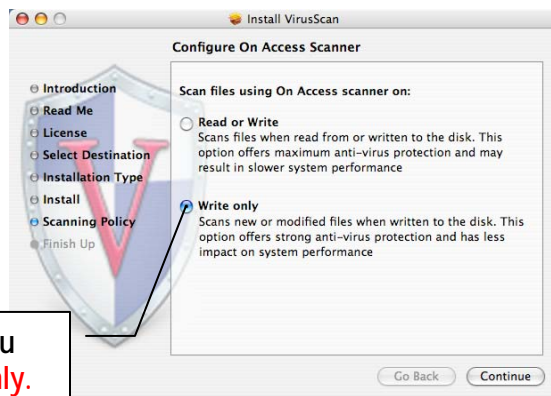
11. Enter your password and click **OK**.



12. You will be shown a window with a progress indicator similar to the one below as the application installs.



13. When the installation is complete, you will be shown a window with two choices: whether to scan files for viruses when they are written on to or read from the hard drive, or to scan files only when they are written on to the hard drive. Check **Write only** and click on **Continue**.



Make sure you select **Write only**.

14. You will be prompted to restart your machine to finish the installation. Click on **Restart** to finish the installation.
