LGBT: A Union Perspective

This artistic exhibit will broadly explore issues surrounding the LGBT community at Union College and beyond. Some examples of issues include diversity, personal identity, discrimination, etc. The Union College Community is invited to participate by submitting artwork that reflects a thoughtful interpretation of this theme. This is a juried exhibition and there will be a \$100 prize for Best of Show, as well as additional prizes. This exhibition will take place at the Wikoff Gallery in the Nott Memorial from April 7 – May 18, 2008 coinciding with the National Day of Silence on April 25, 2008. Accepted artwork will be displayed in the exhibition and/or performed at the exhibition opening reception.

- ◆ **Needed:** Original artwork in any medium or form—including but not limited to painting, sculpture, photography, works of fiction, mixed media, music or other, perhaps undefined, type of art or interdisciplinary work.** There is no limit to the number of works submitted by individual artists.

March 10-14, 2008 (8:00am-4:00pm): Submissions Accepted
April 1-2 (8:00am-4:00pm): Work not to be included in the show can be picked up
- ◆ All works can be dropped off and picked up at the **Schaffer Library, Collection Development Office, Room 122** with Courtney Seymour. **No work** is to be submitted without the attached registration form. Additional registration forms for multiple submissions will be made available at the Wikoff Gallery, Schaffer Library or online through the Schaffer Library and LGBT Allies websites.

**Work must be smaller than 8 ft. high x 4 ft. wide. Installation of sculpture must be logistically feasible. All work must be ready to hang [i.e. framed, etc.]. The organizers of the event retain the right to reject any work based on size or other specific determinations.
