Subject: Online Ballot on Course Evaluation Forms

Dear Colleague,

Voting faculty will soon receive an online ballot in a separate email to determine whether to replace the current end-of-term student course evaluation forms with new ones proposed by the Faculty Review Board after a subcommittee report, discussion, faculty meetings, and a straw poll concerning inclusion of a global question on the proposed new forms.

The proposed new forms are attached; they are labeled v31, with one standard form for classroom courses and one for the evaluation of studio or lab components of courses.

A reminder: The only modification the FRB has made to the proposed new forms as discussed at the faculty meeting (the earlier v30) is to include a global question at the end (#14 on v31) and to make that global question open-ended. That modification makes the new forms consistent with the majority preferences in the faculty straw poll recently conducted by the FEC.

The FRB unanimously endorses the new forms and has submitted them for a final faculty vote because they represent a policy change. The ballot therefore asks whether you approve the new forms (v31) or want to continue with our current forms.

All ballots must be submitted by 5:00 PM on Friday, April 27th.
