Successful applicants:

- Have a B+ average or above in the core high school courses (English, History, Math, Science, World Language).
- Will be ranked in the top 10% or 20% of their graduating class, if school offers rank.
- Will be taking challenging courses (Honors, AP or IB).
- Have a New York Regents average of 80 or above, ELA score of 80 or above, and no Regents scores below 65, if school offers Regents testing.
- Present an 1100 on the old SAT, 1170 on the new SAT, or 25 on the ACT. Submission of test scores is optional.
- Have a genuine interest in learning more about the academic and community experience at Union College.
- Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
