# DESCRIPTION OF COURSES NOT IN THE 2016-17 ACADEMIC CATALOG

**\*Includes Revised Course Descriptions\***

**ADA-041 The Moving Body Practicum.** Moutillet, M., Crawley, L. class will focus on the study of a fusion of dance styles to provide a welcoming class to our dancers or non-dancers at Union College. Taught to music, this technique dance class will include some contemporary dance vocabulary, a study of muscular elongation of the body and the development of one's physical potential. Special emphasis will be given to proper warm up, awareness of body isolation and placement in order to enhance endurance and flexibility. Open to all interested in learning and experiencing the fundamentals of the dance discipline.

**ADA-160 Dance for the Camera.** Moutillet, M. This course focuses on the process of making dances for the camera, uniting the various aesthetics of movement and the practical elements of recording visual material. Since the arrival of the digital chip, the light camera, and various computer programs, we have seen a revolution in dances created for the screen, Slideroom, YouTube or Vimeos. Methods will focus on conceptualized movement, phrase development, compositional tools and framing, as well as design production. Through discussions, decision-making, individual and collaborative work, the designated choreographer/director, crew and cameraperson will develop a sense of craft used in the art of making dances for video viewing. The student challenge will be to invent a unique dance language to communicate ideas, intentions and feelings through the medium of video making. Dance moves – with their complexity, richness, rhythmical and compelling imagery - will be at the core of their creative work. CC: HUM

**AVA-215 Life Drawing.** An intensive study of the human figure. Working from live models, issues of form, proportion, gesture, composition, and expressive possibilities will be explored and practiced. CC: HUM

**CLS-200 International Relations and Law of the Ancient World.** Bedford, P. International relations (IR) and international law are not modern concepts. They are evident in the ancient world and their study gives us insight into the character of ancient states, the conception of 'foreign' or competing polities, the role of law in relations between states, the significance of religion in political identity, and the development of early empires, among other things. This class takes up a number of historical examples from the wider Mediterranean world in order to explore relevant issues: the 'Amarna Age' in the ancient Near East (relations between Egypt, Hatti, Mitanni, Assyria, Babylonia, and the city-states of the Levant) (1400-1300 BC); the emergence and organization of the Neo-Assyrian Empire in the ancient Near East (950-600 BC) through client states and treaties; Athenian hegemony over neighboring Greek city-states (5<sup>th</sup> century BC); 'Friendship' between states in the Roman world and its emerging empire (353-146 BC). Students interested in ancient history, comparative politics, international relations, law, or religion will find topics to engage in this class. CC: HUM, LCC

**ECO-227 A History of American Financial Crises.** Holt, H. This course covers American financial history, focusing on the various crisis periods the US has experienced from the late 19th century to the present. Particularly, we will emphasize the important role that policy and financial regulation has had in causing and influencing these crisis periods. The course begins with an introduction/review of basic finance and banking concepts, as well as relevant political economy theories necessary to understand the intimate relationship that the financial sector has with the US federal and state governments. We begin our study of individual crisis periods with the National Banking Era crises of the late 19th and early 20th century. We then move to the founding of the Federal Reserve in 1912-1914, and its subsequent role in not only failing to prevent the Great Depression, but also causing it to be significantly more destructive. We finish the course by examining the 2008 financial crisis, again with an emphasis on the mistakes made by US policy in shaping an environment that made a crisis inevitable. Students should leave this course with a full understanding of the history of American financial crises, debate its causes, and contribute to the current public debate over finance and regulation. Prerequisite: ECO-101.

**ECO-238 Women Technology and Globalization.** Sener, M.F. We explore the effects of technology and globalization on women's economic outcomes. Does increased trade improve the working conditions of women? How does the expansion of the global fertility industry affect the economic opportunities available to women? How do new technologies, such as the birth control pill and the IVF technology, affect the economic decisions of women? Why are women underrepresented in high-tech industries? To what extent do women find the opportunity to get involved in the knowledge creation economy? Prerequisite: ECO-101.

**EGL-223 Jane Austen.** Doyle, K. Jane Austen, like Shakespeare, is that rare "canonical" author whose name and work remain alive for readers hundreds of years after her era. In this course we will read all six of her novels, along with material she wrote as a teenager, in chronological order, watching her artistic skill develop over three decades. How did Austen challenge the literary status quo? What issues most intrigued her as she created each of her novels? What issues in her work still resonate with us today? Prerequisite: EGL-100, EGL-101 or EGL-102, or faculty permission. CC:HUL, HUM

**EGL-261 British Modernism.** Mitchell, J. This course examines British fiction from the early twentieth-century, a period often referred to as the "modernist" era. The moderns experimented with new, different, and exciting ways of writing that perplexed many readers, yet such changes have come to be seen as important innovations in style. In addition to engaging with questions of form and style, the moderns were also interested in subjects that were previously viewed as taboo, questionable, and, as such, often unspeakable. Such topics include trauma, the lasting effects of war, sexual experimentation, adultery, insanity, and newly carved out gender and familial roles. Throughout our term together, you will be asked to critically consider, discuss, and write about the relationship between the content of modernist writing and its innovative style and form. Prerequisite: EGL-100, EGL-101 or EGL-102, or faculty permission. CC: HUL, HUM

**MTH-062 Mathematics of Elections and Polls.** Jauregui, J. In the 2012 U.S. presidential election, how was Nate Silver able to correctly predict the outcome in all 50 states? Why did Landon lose decisively to Roosevelt in 1936 despite Literary Digest's well-trusted poll predicting the opposite? This course will address these questions and many others. For example, how much should polls be trusted? What are margins of error? How many people must be surveyed for accurate results? Which people? To help answer these questions, the course will include background material on probability and statistics. Along the way we will discuss quantitative aspects of elections and polls in general, alternative voting systems, and of course, the upcoming U.S. presidential election. CC: QMR

**MTH-257-01 Mathematical Foundations of Game Theory.** Zwicker, B. Basics of non-cooperative and cooperative game theory, including games in normal and extensive form, mixed strategies, existence of Nash Equilibria via fixed-point theorems, the core of a cooperative game, stable matchings; the emphasis is on proof and conceptual foundations. This course is appropriate for Economics majors with a strong interest in mathematics, as well as for Mathematics minors and majors in general. Prerequisite: MTH-199. CC: QMR

**MTH-487-01 Senior Writing Seminar.** MTH Staff. This course is required by, and limited to, seniors who are not satisfying their WS requirement through either a one- or two-term thesis. The seminar will provide a forum in which students continue their study of group theory and explore a new topic in group theory independently. Students will gain experience in giving oral presentations and writing mathematical papers. CC: QMR, WS

**MLT-300 History and Environment of Siberia.** Bidoshi, K. Siberia is renowned for its pristine environment. It holds twenty percent of the planet's forest reserves and twenty percent of the world's surface fresh water. This course is designed to give students a comprehensive understanding of the environmental history of Siberia: from colonization, through Soviet industrialization to her transition to a market economy. The focus of the course is on the environment. Topics discussed include: principles of conservation biology, geographical information systems, ecological tourism, history of the Trans-Siberian railroad, wildlife management and sacred Buryati sites in Eastern Siberia. The course is conducted as a combination of lectures and discussions. Guest lecturers from Adirondack Wild, Albany Pine Bush, Tyler Technologies, and Union's Departments of Biology, Chemistry, Economics, Engineering, Geology, and History. CC: HUL, LCC

**PSC-336 Prudence.** Seri, G. Why do we praise Socrates for choosing to obey the law at the cost of his own life, and Mohandas Gandhi and Martin Luther King for engaging in civil disobedience? How do we know when disobeying the government is the right thing to do? If the political involves making decisions that define the fate of entire communities, where and how can we learn to judge, decide, and act wisely? In his *Nicomachean Ethics*, Aristotle defines *phronēsis*, commonly translated as practical wisdom or prudence, as the eminently political virtue of producing "right judgments about what is to be done" in concrete, unique, and unrepeatable circumstances with a view of the common good. Necessary to govern well and key in advancing the good life, prudence is contextual. It cannot be reduced to principles of simple transmission nor disciplined by science. Instead, its cultivation calls for experience and deliberation and, after Cicero, also for good public speaking. Crediting rhetoric with transmitting practical wisdom, the tradition would then encompass the study of the lives and speeches of heroes and leaders. Prudential concerns informed the education of statesmen and princes for centuries afterwards. Because of its association with princely matters and its conflicting relation with and irreducibility to universal laws and science, modern political philosophers distrusted *phronēsis*. Still, the instrumental excesses of modern rationality leading to environmental degradation, totalitarianism, or nuclear catastrophes have favored an ongoing "revival" of prudence. It seems more and more clear that democratic life in hard times demands prudent leaders and the cultivation of prudential citizenship. Taking inspiration in old traditions but with a contemporary edge, in this class we will critically revisit and assess the possibilities of prudence—both in its classical and postmodern versions—to inform our own political puzzles as well as the epistemological bases for an interpretive political science. The format of the class should facilitate the deliberation and related discursive practices required by prudential reasoning. Prerequisite: PSC-113 or sophomore standing.

**PSC-339 Seminar in Political Theory: Black Radical Politics and the Legacies of Malcolm X.** Marso, L.J. In this seminar, we will explore the legacy of Malcolm X for Black radical politics and the Black Lives Matter movement today. We will dissect and compare Malcolm's vision with other Black radicals that draw on and depart from his. Reading Manning Marable's controversial biography alongside *The Autobiography of Malcolm X* and the website developed by Marable and his students, we will first explore Malcolm's history and legacy to see how class politics, ideological differences, and perspectives on sex and gender within the Black community impact how Malcolm is described, remembered, and lionized. We will also consider Malcolm's legacy through an internationalist lens, one of Manning Marable's contributions. Finally, we will discover how Black nationalists and Muslims the world over have claimed Malcolm as their own, with their own emphases and nuanced narratives.

Underlying questions throughout our discussions will be: What are the politics of memory? What is at stake in how we frame, celebrate, or critique a figure like Malcolm X? When we focus on sexuality and gender, does the vision of what is radical change, and if so, how and why? To explore these questions and others that arise, our seminar will also view Malcolm in comparative perspective vis-à-vis women activists and thinkers such as Ella Baker, and other Black Radical thinkers such as James Baldwin. Prompted by films and contemporary writings, we will also discuss how Malcolm is viewed today. Ultimately, we want to uncover the political stakes in constructing these very different legacies. In the final few weeks of the seminar we will read some contemporary work in the tradition of Black radicalism with Malcolm's legacy in mind. Prerequisites: PSC-111, PSC-112, or PSC-113 and permission of instructor.

**SPN-408 Digital Storytelling in Contemporary Spain.** Henseler, C. Students will explore digital storytelling, both in theory and in practice. From Twitter literature to blog novels, hypertexts and crowdsourced narratives, students will navigate various digital spaces developed by contemporary authors of the Hispanic world. What is digital storytelling? What happens to the content and form of a story when it enters digital space? What is gained? What is lost? And what assumptions are questioned along the way? Through hands-on workshops and highly interactive discussions, students will investigate the historical manifestations of different forms of digital storytelling, they will entertain new theoretical frameworks, and they will question the changing dynamics of storytelling through concepts such as authorship, reading, participation, immersion, interaction, space and time. Prerequisite: Two 300-level Spanish courses. CC: HUM, LCCS.

## COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM

Courses numbered 0-49 carry no credit. Courses numbered 50-99 are designated for Common Curriculum or do not count for the major. Courses numbered 100-199 are all introductory level offerings. Courses numbered 200-299 are those at the sophomore/junior level that may also be taken by non-majors. Courses numbered 300-399 are upper-level that are primarily intended for majors, i.e., which represent the depth component of the major. Courses numbered 400-499 are all advanced level courses for seniors, including those used to fulfill the Senior Writing Experience (WS), seminars, research, thesis and independent studies.
