Locate a provider near you, online, anytime.

Go to www.cdphp.com and click on Find-A-Doc on the home page. Then follow these three easy steps to begin your search:

- Step 1:** Select plan type: CDPHN – Self-Insured Plans, and choose MagnaCare/First Health from the Extended Network drop-down. Or, enter your member ID.
- Step 2:** Enter an address, city and state, or ZIP code, as well as how far out you want to search.
- Step 3:** Indicate the specialty (type of doctor) you want to find. If you are looking for a specific physician or group, enter the name in the field provided.

Your search results will appear sorted by the closest distance to your specified location. You may also choose to sort your results alphabetically by last name.

TIP

There are thousands of physicians in our network. You can narrow your search results by choosing from one of the options shown on the left side of the results page, including gender, specialty, hospitals, and languages.
