Course selections must be made in consultation with faculty advisors. The 2010-11 Academic Register contains full descriptions of courses as well as information on pre-requisites. Additional course descriptions may be found within this document.

COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM: Courses numbered 0-49 carry no credit. Courses numbered 50-99 are designated for General Education or do not count for the major. Courses numbered 100-199 are all introductory level offerings. Courses numbered 200-299 are those at the sophomore/junior level that may also be taken by non-majors. Courses numbered 300-399 are upper-level that are primarily intended for majors, i.e., which represent the depth component of the major. Courses numbered 400-499 are all advanced level courses for seniors, including those used to fulfill the Senior Writing Experience (WS), seminars, research, thesis and independent studies.

COURSE LOAD: Written Permission from your advisor is required and must be submitted to the Office of the Registrar when taking less than the normal course load [three (3) courses] per term. Please see Page 2 for information regarding fourth courses.

No student will be allowed to register for a language course unless they:

- 1) have a signed placement recommendation form/petition or
- 2) have taken the prerequisite course **here at Union**.

DISCLOSURE OF DIRECTORY INFORMATION: Union College hereby designates the following student information as public or “Directory Information.” Such information may be disclosed by the institution for any purpose, at its discretion:

Name, address (campus, home, e-mail), telephone numbers, date and place of birth, academic fields of study, dates of attendance, ID photographs, participation in recognized activities and sports, degrees and awards, weight and height of athletic team members, most previous educational agency or institution attended, or other similar information. The College may publicize or respond to requests for such information at its discretion. However the use of these records for commercial or political purposes is prohibited unless approved by the Vice President for Academic Affairs.

Union College assumes that failure on the part of any student to specifically request the withholding of “Directory Information” indicates individual approval for disclosure. Furthermore, pursuant to the terms of the Family Educational Rights & Privacy Act of 1974, as amended, Union College reserves the right to publish or release any or all of the above “Directory Information” for internal institutional use only, whether or not a student requests the withholding of such information by the means indicated above.

Fourth Course Policy

The annual tuition at Union allows a student to register for three terms taking three courses per term. This allows students to complete the required 36 courses for graduation. In some Engineering programs as many as 40 courses may be required and those students are permitted to enroll in 10 courses per year. Under certain circumstances students may be allowed to take a fourth course in a term.

Students who are making satisfactory progress in their program of study are allowed to enroll in one fourth course during an academic year at no extra charge, provided they have a GPA of at least 3.3. These courses can be used to enhance the student’s academic experience at Union. All such courses will appear on the transcript and can be used to fulfill program requirements; however, they can not be used for the purpose of accelerated graduation. (This includes fourth courses taken on a Term Abroad.)

Fourth courses can also be used to make up a deficiency in credits due to withdrawals or failure. A 4th course fee will be charged under these circumstances (for 2010-2011 the fee will be approximately \$3,075). Students whose GPA is below 2.5 will need the written permission from Dean Bidoshi before signing up for a fourth course.

All students, including engineering students, with the exception of Leadership in Medicine (LIM) and Scholar Students will be required to fill out the “Petition to Enroll in a Fourth Course” form. General Education Requirements

Part A: Core

First-Year Preceptorial and Sophomore Research Seminar

- First-year students will be assigned to an FPR section one term during their first year.
- In spring of their first year, students will express their preferences for their SRS section, and will be assigned to an SRS in one term during their sophomore year. (Note that Union Scholars take their Scholars Research Seminar in their first year.)
- Neither FPR nor SRS will be credited toward any major or minor.

Part B: Distribution

Social Sciences (1)

- Any course listed in a Social Sciences department (Anthropology, Economics, History, Political Science, & Sociology) or PSY-100 will satisfy the Social Sciences distribution requirement.

Humanities (2) one must be a literature course.

- Any course listed in a Humanities department (Classics, English, Modern Languages, Music, Philosophy, Theater and Dance, Visual Arts) will satisfy the Humanities distribution requirement.
- Any English or MLT course will satisfy the literature requirement. (HUL)
- Any other course carrying the “HUL” (Humanities – Lit) designation will satisfy the Literature requirement under the Humanities distribution requirement.

Linguistic and Cultural Competency (2)

- Two courses to demonstrate Linguistic and Cultural Competency. This requirement can be satisfied in one of three ways:
 - a sequence of two courses in one foreign language at level 101 or higher
 - any two courses designated “LCC”
 - term abroad courses (including mini-terms) dealing with a cultural tradition outside the U.S.

Quantitative and Mathematical Reasoning (1)

- One course to demonstrate quantitative and mathematical reasoning, includes courses in the Mathematics department or those offered in any other department carrying the “QMR” designation.

Science and Technology (2)

- One course in natural sciences, with lab, listed as “SCLB”
- One course selected from the following categories:
 - i. a second science course, but need not have a lab
 - ii. a course from engineering or computer science, to foster understanding of technology
 - iii. a team-taught ID course (including at least one faculty from Division 3 or 4), with significant science or engineering content, about the impact of science and/or technology on the human world, listed as “SET” (Science/Engineering/Technology).

Part C: Connections across Disciplines (Clusters)

- Clusters prompt awareness of interdisciplinary connections by requiring students to take three courses in an approved cluster, from at least two different departments. Students may automatically satisfy the Cluster requirement by completing either a major or a minor in any interdisciplinary or organizing theme program.

Writing Across the Curriculum (WAC): There are three components built into your curriculum. The first is in Part A of the Gen Ed curriculum above (First-Year Preceptorial and the Sophomore (or Scholars) Research Seminar). The second is enrolling in at least five courses (in two different divisions) designated “WAC.” The third is a capstone senior writing experience (thesis or research seminar), generally done as part of your major.

Declaration of Cluster: Students should indicate how they plan to complete the cluster requirement no later than the end of their sophomore year. This can be done through the WebAdvising system (<https://webadvising.union.edu>). Students make their choice through a drop-down menu on the Cluster Selection page of WebAdvising. Students may

change their choice at any time. Advisors will see the student's cluster choice listed under the major and minor information on their WebAdvising screen.

*** DESCRIPTIONS OF COURSES NOT IN THE 2010-2011 ACADEMIC REGISTER ***

ADA-037 Zumba Dance Class. L. Cowley. Zumba combines high energy and motivating music with unique moves and combinations that allow the Zumba participants to dance. It is based on the principle that dance steps are fun and easy to follow allowing Zumba participants to enjoy the art of dancing and achieve long-term health benefits. Zumba is a “feel-good” workout that is great for both the body and the mind. ZUMBA is a fusion of Latin and International music – dance themes that create a dynamic, exciting, and effective aerobic/fitness training with a combination of fast and slow rhythms that tone and sculpt the body. This movement class is meant to engage trained and non-trained dancers. Experience a fusion of diverse dance styles such as salsa, reggaeton, merengue, cha-cha, belly dance, cumbia and more.

ANT-193 Caste, Religion & Politics in India. J. Witsoe. This course will explore caste, religion and politics in India. Combining political economy readings with ethnography, this course will examine cultural and historical dimensions of caste and religion in India and will focus particularly on the ways religion and caste have interacted with politics in the 20th and 21st century. By the end of the course, students will have a good grasp of contemporary and historical variation in expression of caste and religion in India and how these have influenced 20th and 21st century political movements.

CLS-230 Judaism & Christian Origins. P. Bedford. See REL 230.

ECE 011 Practicum:Electrical & Computer Engineering. Staff. Hands-on exercises, lectures and guest speakers will demonstrate practical applications of ECE and how these applications are related to the core curriculum. Each offering of the course will have a central theme, such as audio engineering, speech acoustics, energy and the environment, power systems, digital signal processing, global communications, nanotechnology, microscopy (scanning electron microscopy, atomic force microscopy), optics, robotics, etc. This practicum will be of interest to students who would like more information about career paths that are possible with an Electrical and Computer Engineering degree. To receive pass/fail credit equivalent to one elective course, a student must receive a passing grade in three-terms of practicum.

GEO-215 Stable Isotopes in Environmental Science w/Lab. Staff. Stable isotopes have become a fundamental tool in many biogeoscientific studies, from reconstructing past climates to tracking animal migration or unraveling food webs and even to study the origin of life on Earth and possibly other planets. This course highlights the applications of stable isotopes in biological, ecological, environmental, archeological and geological studies. Students learn the fundamentals of stable isotope biogeochemistry in order to understand the uses and imitations of this tool. This course starts with an introduction to the fundamentals of stable isotope geochemistry and then moves on to applied topics such as paleoceanography and paleoclimatology proxies, hydrology, sediments and sedimentary rocks, biogeochemical cycling, the global carbon cycle, photosynthesis, metabolism, ecology, organic matter degradation, pollution, and more. Prerequisites: Any intro GEO, BIO or CHM course. **Petition required.**

HBR-111 Biblical Hebrew 1. P. Bedford. Study of elementary Biblical Hebrew grammar with selected readings from the Hebrew Bible.

IDM-210 The Culture of Respect. P. Poczik. This course is an examination of systems of oppression. In particular we will be exploring: racism, sexism, classism, heterosexism, ableism, ageism, and religious oppression. The approach we will take to study these topics is one of experiential learning. As the students in the class, you will essentially be the textbooks for our study. Much of our time will be spent exploring the misinformation and stereotypes that enable systems of oppression to exist and perpetuate. These conversations are either going to be really hard or hardly real. It is up to you as students to determine the quality of this educational experience. Our goal is to draw connections between the various systems of oppression, to recognize how we can be allies to each other across identities by building coalitions, and ultimately to leave the class equipped with tools that will enable us to interrupt cycles of oppression.

IDM-340 Suspense! Alfred Hitchcock. J. de Seve. Learn how to structure and produce suspense films in this fun, hands-on course. Building off the work of suspense legend Alfred Hitchcock, this class will take a critical approach to analyzing the elements that makes film suspense work. We will work as a class in a full pre-production, production and post-production of a suspense thriller. Prerequisites: IDM-201 or IDM-202 or IDM-204. **Petition Required.**

PSC-255 International Security. D.Watson. Much of our understanding of international relations has focused on the perceived and real threats to international security. Over time these threats have included nuclear, biological, and chemical weapons designed to kill millions of people in a single attack. More recently concerns have focused on those who would use these weapons as much as the weapons themselves, making rogue states and terrorist groups in particular the most recognized threats to international security. Now add to this the increasing concerns over cyber terrorism and environmental causes of conflict and the world seems beset by dangers. This course seeks to critically examine those dangers and the policies developed to deal with them. Core issues to be examined will be sources of and responses to state insecurity, WMDs, multilateral conflict resolution, and the ramifications of US hegemony for international security

PSC-336 Prudence. G. Seri. If the political involves making decisions that define the fate of entire communities, where and how can we learn to judge and decide wisely? In his *Nicomachean Ethics*, Aristotle defines *phronēsis*, commonly translated as practical wisdom or prudence, as the eminently political virtue of producing “right judgments about what is to be done” in concrete circumstances. While a concern with prudence informed the Ancient and Medieval education of statesmen and princes, in this seminar we will revisit and assess the possibilities of the tradition of prudential governance – in both its classical and postmodern versions – to inform contemporary political puzzles as well as the epistemological bases for an interpretive political science. Prerequisites: PSC 111 & PSC 112 or Sophomore standing.

REL-230 Judaism & Christian Origins. P. Bedford. We know that Jesus of Nazareth was Jewish, so how is it that Christianity and Judaism became separate religions? This course attempts to answer this question by investigating the nature of the relationship between earliest Christianity and early rabbinic Judaism, drawing out their shared roots in the religion and literature of ancient Israel, and exploring the diverse expressions of second temple Judaism among which the two religious traditions emerged. It also explores their distinctive religious teachings and scriptural interpretations with a particular interest in understanding how and why Christianity and Judaism, despite their commonalities, parted ways and became independent religions. **No Freshmen.**

SPN-411 Contemporary Spanish Women Writers: Post Franco Era. G. Ignizio. In this course we will examine the notion of a category of women’s literature in the context of post-dictatorship and contemporary Spain. Specifically, we will explore a selection of novels and short stories published by twentieth-century Spanish women writers, such as Esther Tusquets and Lucía Etxebarria. During the term we will analyze the works from a variety of perspectives and apply critical theory readings that will frame class discussions. Students will also study the social and political changes in Spain after the death of Francisco Franco. This class will address topics, such as “el destape,” feminism, the rise of democracy, and gender issues. The goals of the course, in addition to acquainting majors and minors with significant works of peninsular literature, include strengthening reading ability and sharpening critical-thinking skills. Prerequisites: Two 300-Level SPN courses.
