Course selections must be made in consultation with faculty advisors. The 2009-10 Academic Register gives full descriptions of courses as well as information on prerequisites. Additional course descriptions may be found within this document.

COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM: Courses numbered 0-49 will be those that carry no credit. Courses numbered 50-99 are designated for General Education or other courses that do not count for the major. Courses numbered 100-199 are all introductory level offerings. Courses numbered 200-299 are those at the sophomore/junior level that may also be taken by non-majors. Courses numbered 300-399 are upper-level which are primarily intended for majors, i.e. courses which represent the depth component of the major. Courses numbered 400-499 are all advanced level courses for seniors, including those used to fulfill the Senior Writing Experience (WS), seminars, research, thesis and independent studies.

COURSE LOAD: Written Permission from your advisor is required and must be submitted to the Office of the Registrar when taking less than the normal course load [three (3) courses] per term. Please see Page 2 for information regarding fourth courses.

No student will be allowed to register for a language course unless they:

- 1) have a signed placement recommendation form/petition or
- 2) have taken the prerequisite course **here at Union.**

DISCLOSURE OF DIRECTORY INFORMATION: Union College hereby designates the following student information as public or “Directory Information.” Such information may be disclosed by the institution for any purpose, at its discretion:

Name, address (campus, home, e-mail), telephone numbers, date and place of birth, academic fields of study, dates of attendance, ID photographs, participation in recognized activities and sports, degrees and awards, weight and height of athletic team members, most previous educational agency or institution attended, or other similar information. The College may publicize or respond to requests for such information at its discretion. However the use of these records for commercial or political purposes is prohibited unless approved by the Vice President for Academic Affairs.

Union College assumes that failure on the part of any student to specifically request the withholding of “Directory Information” indicates individual approval for disclosure. Furthermore, pursuant to the terms of the Family Educational Rights & Privacy Act of 1974, as amended, Union College reserves the right to publish or release any or all of the above “Directory Information” for internal institutional use only, whether or not a student requests the withholding of such information by the means indicated above.

Fourth Course Policy

The annual tuition at Union allows a student to register for three terms taking three courses per term. This allows students to complete the required 36 courses for graduation. In some Engineering programs as many as 40 courses may be required and those students are permitted to enroll in 10 courses per year. Under certain circumstances students may be allowed to take a fourth course in a term.

Students who are making satisfactory progress in their program of study are allowed to enroll in one fourth course during an academic year at no extra charge, provided they have a GPA of at least 3.3. These courses can be used to enhance the student’s academic experience at Union. All such courses will appear on the transcript and can be used to fulfill program requirements; however, they can not be used for the purpose of accelerated graduation. (This includes fourth courses taken on a Term Abroad.)

Fourth courses can also be used to make up a deficiency in credits due to withdrawals or failure or if a student does not have the requisite GPA. A 4th course fee will be charged under these circumstances (for 2009-2010 the fee will be approximately \$2,965). Students whose GPA is below 2.5 will need the written permission of Dean Bidoshi before signing up for a fourth course.

All students, including engineering students, with the exception of Leadership in Medicine (LIM) and Scholar Students will be required to fill out the “Petition to Enroll in a Fourth Course” form. CROSS REGISTRATION

Please Note: Union College and *Union Graduate College are two separate Colleges. All graduate level courses taken by Union undergraduates, including Leadership in Medicine and Combined Degree students will be taken through Union Graduate College and will require completion of a special “Union Graduate College” Cross Registration Form. These forms are available in the Registrar’s Office in Silliman Hall.

Cross Registration has been a service of the Member Institutions of the Hudson Mohawk Association since 1970, when the Association was chartered by the New York State Board of Regents. The purpose of the cross registration program is to provide students the opportunity to study areas not represented by the offerings of their home college, at no additional tuition charge. In addition to general guidelines, each college has its own set of regulations, regarding cross-registration and students should make themselves aware of these for both their home campus and the campus they are visiting.

General Education Requirements

Part A: Core

First-Year Preceptorial and Sophomore Research Seminar

- First-year students will be assigned to an FPR section one term during their first year.
- In Spring of their first year, students will express their preferences for their SRS section, and will be assigned to an SRS in one term during their sophomore year. (Note that Union Scholars take their Scholars Research Seminar in their first year.)
- Neither FPR nor SRS will be credited toward any major or minor.

Part B: Distribution

Social Sciences (1)

- Any course listed in a Social Sciences department (Anthropology, Economics, History, Political Science, & Sociology) or PSY-100 will satisfy the Social Sciences distribution requirement.

Humanities (2) one must be a literature course.

- Any course listed in a Humanities department (Classics, English, Modern Languages, Music, Philosophy, Theater and Dance, Visual Arts) will satisfy the Humanities distribution requirement.
- Any English or MLT course will satisfy the literature requirement.
- Any other course carrying the “HUL” (Humanities – Lit) designation will satisfy the Literature requirement under the Humanities distribution requirement.

Linguistic and Cultural Competency (2)

- Two courses to demonstrate Linguistic and Cultural Competency. This requirement can be satisfied in one of three ways:
 - a sequence of two courses in one foreign language at level 101 or higher
 - any two courses designated “LCC”
 - term abroad courses (including mini-terms) dealing with a cultural tradition outside the U.S.

Quantitative and Mathematical Reasoning (1)

- One course to demonstrate quantitative and mathematical reasoning, includes courses in the Mathematics department or those offered in any other department carrying the “QMR” designation.

Science and Technology (2)

- One course in natural sciences, with lab, listed as “SCLB”
- One course selected from the following categories:
 - i. a second science course, but need not have a lab
 - ii. a course from engineering or computer science, to foster understanding of technology
 - iii. a team-taught ID course (including at least one faculty from Division 3 or 4), with significant science or engineering content, about the impact of science and/or technology on the human world, or any other course listed as “SET” (Science/Engineering/Technology).

Part C: Connections across Disciplines (Clusters)

- Clusters prompt awareness of interdisciplinary connections by requiring students to take three courses in an approved cluster, from at least two different departments. Students may automatically satisfy the Cluster requirement by completing either a major or a minor in any interdisciplinary or organizing theme program.

- **Declaration of Cluster:** Students should indicate how they plan to complete the cluster requirement no later than the end of their sophomore year. Students may change their choice at any time. Advisors will see the student’s cluster choice listed under the major and minor information on their WebAdvising screen.

***** DESCRIPTIONS OF COURSES NOT IN THE 2009-2010 ACADEMIC REGISTER *****

AAH 205 Art and Science of Painting. L. Matthew and M. Carroll. A historical and chemical grounding in the topic of painting and its impact on society, with focus on the 14th to 17th centuries. Topics include inorganic and organic pigments and binders used in the late medieval workshop, fresco, the tempera tradition, and oil painting in the Renaissance (properties of oil, mixing with pigments, glazing, drying). Students will work with primary sources and the secondary literature, and engage in laboratory experimentation. **GenEd: SET. Petition Required.**

ADA 072 Choreography – Ensemble. M. Moutillet. The Choreography- Ensemble class will give students the opportunity to participate in the creation of a dance piece. The studio classes will focus on South American dances that will generate choreographic scenes. The dance vocabulary will be the amalgam of contemporary Latino dance styles and music. Students will have the opportunity to learn new dance steps as well as interacting in the process by sharing their own individual perspective on Latino music. The dance scenes will use live music as well as incorporating inventive sets for a contemporary performative art production. Each week the class will build on material that will be rehearsed and finally presented as part of the Winter Dance Concert 2010 at the Yulman Theater. The collaborative work will take the stage for five representations and will be seen publicly by the entire Union Campus community. Intermediate and advance level. Petition Required.

ADA 073 Choreography – Rhythm. M. Rogers. The Choreography- rhythm class will focus on developing various rhythms to create vibrant sounds and a challenging choreography. This dance vocabulary will stress the primacy of the percussion beats heard in African music. Students will learn to use their entire bodies as an instrument as well as using drums to enhance syncopated beats. Students will have the opportunity to learn new dance steps, rhythms and will interact in the process by sharing their own individual perspective on Latino music. Each week the class will build on material that will be finally presented as part of the Winter Dance Concert 2010. The collaborative work will take the stage for five representations and will be seen publicly by the entire Union Campus community. Intermediate and advance level. Petition Required

AST 058 Astrobiology. J.S. Horton (Biology) and R. Koopmann (Astronomy). Does life exist elsewhere in the universe, or are we alone? The emerging science of astrobiology attempts to answer this fundamental question using an inter-disciplinary approach rooted in biology and astronomy. This course will examine the current state of our scientific knowledge concerning the possibility of life elsewhere in the universe. Topics include: the nature and origin of life on Earth, the possibility of life on Mars and elsewhere in the Solar System, the search for extrasolar planets, the habitability of planets, and the search for extraterrestrial intelligence. **GenEd: SET. Petition Required.**

ATH 104 Twentieth Century Queer Theatre. L. Waiwaiole. Throughout its history, the theatre community and the refugees from erotic orthodoxy have been inseparable companions. The study of this symbiotic relationship offers useful perspectives, which allow one to see how they view each other. The portrayal of non-heterosexual relationships onstage has evolved significantly over time. This survey course of theatre literature will explore the evolution in a variety of theatre pieces written over the span of the 20th century. The class will investigate the influences of queer theatre on the general culture and the current moral attitudes on the theatre. The students will also study major queer playwrights and theatre collaborations as well as various movements within the queer performance world.

BIO 058 Astrobiology. J.S. Horton (Biology) and R. Koopmann (Astronomy). See AST 058

BIO 077 Technology of Biology. J.L. Salvo. Advances in technology have been utilized by scientists and physicians for many centuries. Today, with the rapid developments in molecular biology, the technology often outpaces the understanding and acceptance of the public. This course will look at technological advances relating to biology from both a historical and modern perspective, with an emphasis on how molecular biology has revolutionized our lives. Medical, environmental and industrial topics will be included. **Pre-requisite: College-level math course. Not open to students with Bio 50. GenEd: SET. Petition Required.**

CHM 090 Art and Science of Painting. M. Carroll and L. Matthew. See AAH 205

CHN 401 Media China. H.J. Lin. This course is designed for students who have completed three years of Chinese at the college level or the equivalent. Through reading and viewing more advanced and up-to-date authentic materials from the mass media of China, students will not only develop a higher level of Chinese proficiency through class discussions, written compositions, research presentations but also gain insights into contemporary Chinese as represented in media, including newspaper, television, and the internet. Class will be conducted entirely in Chinese. **Prerequisite: CHN 302 or equivalent or permission from the instructor.**

ECE 386 Intro to Biomedical Instrumentation. S. Hooshangi – Introduction to the theory and application of instruments in medicine. Measurements of the major systems in the body are covered. A weekly laboratory provides an opportunity to perform measurements and use biomedical instruments. Prerequisite: ECE 222 or ECE 225.

GER 340 German-Jewish Writers. A. Passmore. In this course, we will survey the literature and culture of German-speaking, Jewish writers in order to trace the significant influence each culture (German and Jewish) has had on the other. We will use a collection of histories, literature, parables and films to guide us in our discussion. Though we will cover important historical periods in the history of German-speaking Jewish, culture - indeed, civil rights, German nationalism, Nazism, the Shoah and Zionism will all be topics within our purview - the course will not adhere to a strictly linear progression of history. Rather, we will look at literary and non-literary models of intercultural interaction between Germans and Jews, which are similar and yet changing over time. (All readings and discussions are in English, with modified requirements for German credit.) **GenEd: LCC/WAC**

HST 209 Race, Gender, and Nationalism in American Sports. D.P. Brennan. This course will examine the development and the history of sports in the US from the 19th through the 21st centuries with particular focus on sports' intimate bond with nationalism, race, and gender.

HST 342 Jews and Christians in the Islamicate World 600-1800. M. Tadros. See REL 343

IDM 105 Food! Part I. S. Benack. In this course, we will look at food through the lens of many areas of study, including the sciences (the chemistry and biology of food production, cooking and digestion), psychology (the eating motive, food and love/sex, eating disorders), the social sciences (food in culture, food in religious traditions, the economics and politics of food production and distribution), and the humanities (the aesthetics of food, gastronomy as art, artistic representations of food). We'll also do a good deal of first-hand contact with food – eating it, cooking it, painting it, etc. **Note:** This course extends over two terms, but only 1 credit will be earned. **During winter term students sign up for IDM 105 (pass/fail grade only) plus three (3) other credit courses.** During Spring term students will sign up for IDM 106.

LAT 338 Latin Lyric & Elegiac Poetry. M. Toher. Extensive readings from the poems of Catullus, Horace, Propertius, Tibullus, and Ovid. May be repeated with change in author. **Prerequisite: Latin 102 or two years of secondary school Latin. HUL/WAC**

MLT 291 Bad Girls of the Renaissance. S. Triplette. What do a Venetian courtesan, the sister of the king of France, a bourgeoisie from Lyon, an obscure aristocrat from Madrid, and a Mexican nun have in common? All of these women were writers at a time when the literary world – and literary fame – seemed to be open only to men. In this course, we will explore what it means to be a woman writer in early modern Europe and the Americas, chronicling the restrictions that each of these women faced and overcame in order to produce their work. In many cases, these women's literary ambitions led to or enhanced a bad reputation, placing them on dangerous ground. As we will see, each of these women, living in a time far before the concept feminism even existed, had to find a way to work within the framework of male-dominated literary production. We will examine the work of each woman in the context of her time and social status and attempt, over the course of the semester, to understand how these women laid the foundation for women's writing in later centuries. **GenEd: WAC**

MLT 340 German-Jewish Writers. A. Passmore. See GER 340

PSC 210 Close and Contested Elections. C. Xydias. The first section of this course examines the role of elections in both democratic and non-democratic systems. What are elections intended to accomplish? How do they work? The second, longer, section of the course turns to a series of case studies of recent close and contested elections in a number of different contexts: the United States (2000), Ukraine (2004), Germany (2005), Italy (2006), Mexico (2006), and Iran (2009). This latter portion of the course addresses such questions as (1) the tools and procedures that various kinds of states/regimes have for dealing with such contestation, (2) the extent to which such contested elections may de-legitimize the entire political system, and (3) the role of the media. The final week addresses international election monitoring bodies. **Prerequisites: PSC 111 or PSC 112 or Sophomore standing.**

REL 343 Jews and Christians in the Islamicate World 600-1800. M. Tadros. The intent of this course is to capture the essence of Jewish, Christian and Muslim communal relationships from the seventh century to the end of the eighteenth century in the Middle East (and beyond). Through various primary and secondary sources, we will evaluate the levels of cooperation, and of discord, between the "Children of Abraham;" covering such topics as intra- and inter-communal cultural development(s), the status of minorities and the political and commercial opportunities they had, and the intra- and inter-faith polemics. We will also seek to understand the influence, if any, of European merchants and missionaries on the relationship between the three indigenous religions, specifically focusing on the Crusades of the twelfth and thirteenth centuries, and the increased penetration of missionaries and merchants into the Middle East during the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries. This course, although dealing with religious issues, is not intended to delve too deeply into the philosophical and theological aspects of each of these religions, but rather, to investigate how they lived together. **Petition Required.**

SPN 473 Re-viewing Spanish Cinema: From Dictators, Bullfighters and Flamenco to Nationalisms and Globalization. P. Moyano. This course examines the works of such well known artists/filmmakers as Medem, Almodóvar, Bigas Luna, de la Iglesia, Aménabar, among others, who often directly engage with questions of "Spanishness," of the nature of regional and ethnic diversity and identities within Spain, and the place of these identities in the wider framework of filmmaking in Europe. Furthermore, it will also study popular cinema which has been successful in a national context under the Franco regime and since the coming of democracy in the 1970s. **GenEd: WAC.**
