Build Intellectual Foundations

First-Year Preceptorial or **Honors First-Year Preceptorial** engages you in the exploration of ideas and diverse perspectives through critical reading, thinking, and writing. First-year students will be assigned to an FPR section one term during their first year. FPR will not be credited toward any major or minor.

Sophomore Research Seminar or **Scholars Research Seminar** ensures you have an early hands-on experience thinking and working as an academic researcher. In the spring of their first year, students will express their preferences for an SRS section, and will be assigned to an SRS in one term during their sophomore year. (Note that Union Scholars take their Scholars Research Seminar in their first year.) SRS will not be credited toward any major or minor.

Literature (HUL) expands the moral imagination needed to understand yourself and your fellow human beings through literary analysis, interpretation, and reflection. Any course from EGL, MLT, or any courses listed in the course schedule as HUL.

Natural Sciences with Lab (SCLB) changes the way you think about the natural world when you understand the scientific method and put it to work. Any Lab course in AST, BCH, BIO, CHM, ENS, GEO, PHY, and PSY-210 (depending on term) or PSY-312.

Quantitative and Mathematical Reasoning (QMR) equips you with unique insights and skills necessary to solve complex problems. Any course from MTH (except MTH 100) or any courses listed in the course schedule as QMR.

Explore the Liberal Arts

Humanities (HUM) enable you to find yourself and your voice in creative expression and the exploration of works of the imagination. Any course from AAH, AMU, ATH, AVA, CLS, EGL, GRK, LAT, PHL, or courses offered by the Department of Modern Languages and Literatures.

Social Sciences (SOCS) confront you with the complexity and challenges of our world by analyzing the societies we create. Any course from ANT, ECO, HST, PSC, SOC, or PSY-100.

Science, Engineering and Technology (SET) introduces you to Union's unique commitment to teaching Science and Engineering as Liberal Arts and examining their impact on our humanity. Any science (lab or no), Engineering, CSC, or any courses listed in the course schedule as SET.

Create Connections Across Boundaries

Linguistic and Cultural Competency (LCC) empowers you as a citizen of a global community to contribute across cultural boundaries and shape our shared future. Approved Study Abroad, two courses in the same language (at 101 or higher), or any two courses listed in the course schedule as LCC.

Writing Across the Curriculum courses encourage you to explore and create your own understanding of the liberal arts through your writing. <http://www.union.edu/Resources/Academic/WAC/index.php>. Five WAC credits in at least two Divisions and Senior Writing Experience (WS).

Fourth Course Policy

The annual tuition at Union allows a student to register for three terms taking three courses per term. This allows students to complete the required 36 courses for graduation. In some engineering programs as many as 40 courses may be required and those students are permitted to enroll in 10 courses per year. Under certain circumstances students may be allowed to take a fourth course in a term.

Students who are making satisfactory progress in their program of study are allowed to enroll in one fourth course during an academic year at no extra charge, provided they have a GPA of at least 3.3. These courses can be used to enhance the student's academic experience at Union. All such courses will appear on the transcript and can be used to fulfill program requirements; however, **they cannot be used for the purpose of accelerated graduation.** (This includes fourth courses taken on a Term Abroad.)

Fourth courses can also be used to make up a deficiency in credits due to withdrawals or failure. A 4th course fee will be charged under these circumstances. Students whose GPA is below 2.5 will need the written permission from Dean Wunderlich before signing up for a fourth course.

All students, INCLUDING ENGINEERING STUDENTS, with the exception of Leadership in Medicine (LIM) and Scholar Students, will be required to fill out the "Petition to Enroll in a Fourth Course" form. CROSS REGISTRATION

Please Note: Union College and *Union Graduate College are two separate Colleges. All graduate level courses taken by Union undergraduates, including Leadership in Medicine and Combined Degree students will be taken through Union Graduate College and will require completion of a special “Union Graduate College” Cross Registration Form. These forms are available in the Registrar’s Office in Silliman Hall.

AAH-100-01 Intro to Art History and Visual Culture. L. Matthew. This course will introduce students to the field of Art History and the study of Visual Culture. These twin disciplines involve the description, visual analysis, and interpretation of works of art and other visual materials. The course is organized around a set of case studies which will demonstrate the way that a range of themes have been given material and visual form in a number of global cultures and historical periods. Students will learn about the ways that art historians and museum curators have organized knowledge about major artistic monuments, and learn strategies for the verbal and written monuments, but our examination will take in many media, techniques and forms from stained glass mosaic and painting to photography, metalwork and sculpture. This course is designed to provide a foundation for further art historical study, in addition to stimulating curiosity and enthusiasm for the visual world which surrounds all of us.

AAH-270 Arts of India. S. Lullo. This course is designed as an introduction to ways of seeing, understanding, and questioning the visual arts in India. You will learn how the visual arts (cities, architecture, monuments, statues and painting) have informed us about the history and culture of India from the rise of civilization through the Colonial period. It is important to approach the works we will study not simply as objects of aesthetic taste, but as meaningful and functional by those who commissioned, used, created, and experienced them. In addition to studying the social and political nature of the arts, a large portion of this course looks at works that served to activate the sacred within and across several religious belief systems, including Buddhism, Hinduism, and Islam.

BCH 491, 492, 493 Biochemistry Research K. Fox. Requires a thesis based on original scientific research under the direction of a member of the faculty. May be used to satisfy the departmental component for honors in biochemistry and/or to satisfy WS requirements. Expectations include a minimum of twelve hours per week of lab work and attendance at chemistry or biology weekly seminar, in addition to other requirements to be determined by individual research advisors. Prerequisite: Permission of the instructor and third-term junior standing; or permission of the department chair.

IDM-011 Humanism in Medicine. C. Weisse. This experiential learning practicum course will provide an opportunity for students to engage in exercises designed to promote the personal and professional skills necessary to be a good healthcare provider. Students will complete course modules aimed at developing their communication skills while examining topics on cultural competency and other issues that challenge the patient-practitioner relationship such as failure, conflict, and end of life care.

MTH-064 Statistical Thinking. R. Hoerl. Our world is obviously becoming more complex, data-rich, and uncertain (stochastic) every day. This course seeks to provide the conceptual foundation and analytical skills required to understand such a world from a stochastic versus deterministic perspective, and to navigate through the daily bombardment of data from all sides. In addition to developing conceptual understanding and skills in basic graphing, analysis, and problem-solving tools, the course will also present formal statistical methods, such as experimental design, regression analysis, and hypothesis testing. Case studies will be drawn from diverse fields, such as business, sport, genetics, political science, engineering, criminal justice, education, and health policy.

MER-355 Polymeric Materials. S. Kalista. Polymeric materials are introduced from the fundamental level through advanced areas of application. Content will provide the student with an understanding of polymers from a physical perspective, focusing on the relationship between processing, structure, properties and performance. The student will then

be introduced to several advanced engineering topics and the use of polymers in those areas including adhesion science, composite materials, biomaterials, recycling, and self-healing materials. Classroom lectures will be supplemented with demonstrations. Students will explore the current literature and present this information to the class. Prerequisites: MER213 or permission of the instructor.

PHL-263 Issues in Feminism. A. Panaioti. This course aims to provide students with a succinct introduction to post-war feminist theory through the writing of some of its most prominent contemporary proponents. Over the first half of the trimester, we will focus on two important French feminist philosophers, Simone de Beauvoir and Luce Irigaray, paying close attention their relationship with such intellectual movements as existentialism, Marxism, and psychoanalysis. The second half of the trimester will be devoted to the study of two Anglo-American feminist theorists, namely Carole Pateman and Judith Butler. Here, forays into both Neo-Kantian political philosophy (especially Rawls) and post-structuralism (especially Foucault) will be required. Thematically speaking, the regulative question which will guide our enquiry in this course will be: “How/why are women in patriarchal societies oppressed and, in light of one’s answer to this first question, which vehicles of emancipation hold most promise as regards the overcoming of women’s subordination?”

PHL-281 Belief, Truth and Knowledge. D. Barnett. Can you know something even if you have no evidence that it is true? Is it rational to hold political or religious beliefs that you would have rejected had you been raised in a different family or culture? In this advanced introductory course, we will examine these and other questions about what you really know and what you can rationally believe. In addition to these sorts of questions, we will step back and consider the general question of what it is to know something, and what it is to believe something rationally. We will even consider skepticism, the philosophical view that you do not know anything at all.

PHL-337 Gender and Buddhism. A. Panaioti. Buddhism’s relationship to gender is highly ambiguous. Amongst major organised eastern religions, it is arguably that which not only most readily acknowledges women’s intellectual and spiritual potential, but also provides opportunities for its actualization. At the same time, Buddhist monastic institutions throughout history have been profoundly patriarchal, and some of its doctrinal tenets and meditational practices in particular appear outright sexist and objectifying. In this course, gender issues in Buddhism will be examined from a historical and philosophical – as opposed to a sociological, anthropological, or theological – perspective. The first half of the course will be devoted to the careful, historically-sensitive study of Pāli and Classical Indian Buddhist texts which explicitly discuss the status of women – as both agents and objects of (unhealthy male) desire – as well as the female monastic order of *bhikkhunis* and female sainthood. In the second half of the course, we will address distinctly philosophical issues, such as the purported “implicit sexism” in Buddhism’s very struggle against thirsting/desire (*trṣṇā*), the potential implications for gender differentiation of the early Madhyamaka critique of essentialism, and the possible consequences for female agency of the shift from the early Buddhist *arabant* ethical ideal to the *bodhisattva* ideal of Mahāyāna Buddhism.

PHL-411/412 Writing Philosophy Workshop. R. Baker. The goal of this course is to learn how to write philosophy papers. In a sense, writing well is something that transcends disciplinary boundaries, so that a good writer will be a good writer regardless of the topic. Still, some disciplines do have their own peculiarities – and philosophy is one of these. So, we will work hard in developing the skills conducive to write good philosophy papers. It goes without saying that philosophy papers are above all *argumentative*, but there are other features which philosophy papers should exhibit: elegance, verisimilitude, and a good overall narrative strategy. Each student must bring a paper to the course, and then we will collectively revise the paper on multiple occasions.

PSC-209 Rethinking the Past. C. Cidam. The political, social, artistic and scientific developments that took place from the late eighteenth to the twentieth century opened up the way to a world characterized by perpetual disintegration and renewal, struggle and contradiction, expansion of experiential possibilities and destruction of moral boundaries. In this class, we will explore how thinkers of the late modernity turned to the past and constructed “historical” accounts to chart the adventures and horrors of modern life. To do so, we will engage with an array of texts, beginning with Jean-Jacques Rousseau’s *Discourse on the Origins of Inequality* and concluding with Theodor W. Adorno and Max Horkheimer’s *Dialectic of Enlightenment*, all of which reconstruct the past of humanity with a claim to write the history of the present. As we analyze the works of these thinkers, we will try to come to terms with how each of them were moved at once by a will to transform their world and by terror of disorientation of life falling apart. We will ask: How, and to what extent, can these innovative reconstructions of our collective past help us to comprehend the ambiguities of our present.

PSC-291 Urban Politics. A. Dell’Aera. This course is designed to survey the politics of America’s central cities. The actors in this story include machine bosses, reformers, immigrants, bureaucrats, politicians, community organizers, average citizens, criminals, the rich, and the poor. Particular attention will be given to the forms of local government, governing strategies of mayors, populations, types of communities, urban institutions, and policy challenges. The first part of the course will examine various forms of city government, the emergence of urban America, and the rise of political machines.

The second part of the course will study the effects of progressive reforms, the reorganization of city politics and the emergence of race and ethnicity in the post-war city. The third part of the course will examine policy challenges such as poverty, crime, education, and economic development in the contemporary city. We will conclude with a consideration of national urban policy and different ways average citizens can make a difference.

REL-255 Religion, the Body, and Sexuality. O. Solovieva. Is the body a temple of God, a sacred mandala that channels the energies of bliss and wisdom—or is it an impure vessel, a dangerous beast out of control, a prison for the soul? Are female bodies less conducive to spiritual attainments, or are they the most perfect images of the divine? Would having sex diminish one’s spiritual powers and religious standing or enhance them? If you’re looking for answers in the history of religion, the answer to all of those questions is “YES!”. Although the body and its sexual experiences are “natural” on some level, they also are historical constructs which are steeped in imagination of—and must be interpreted within—particular cultures and societies. Throughout human history religious traditions imagined, represented, and utilized human embodiment and sexuality in a variety of ways. In this course we will examine some of these diverse constructions through the study of texts, visual art, and ritual practices of selected traditions such as Tantric Buddhism, Christianity, Graeco-Roman religions, and religions of Mesoamerica. The issues explored in this course include constructions of embodiment, sexuality and gender; theories of erotic desire; relationship between sex and power; and transformative possibilities of sex and sexual renunciation.

SPN-365 Spanish Language and Cultures for the Medical Professions. P. Moyano. This course will introduce students to Spanish vocabulary and grammar --through medical contexts-- as well as the cultural competence. The course is organized around a syllabus by objectives, both linguistically and culturally, as well as the evidence-based clinical protocols, the interview and physical exam. This approach is intended to provide the student with specific information in detail about the goals for each class and session. This includes instruction in medical and colloquial vocabulary, review and analysis of the cross-cultural literature, as well as a comprehensive set of clinically-oriented questions by organ and system which are meant to help with mastering basic communication with the Latino patient in the clinical encounter. Finally, the course is designed to establish a solid foundation for further study of the Spanish and the Latino culture. The skills learned can later be applied when dealing with Latino patients here in the U.S. Prerequisite: SPN 203 or permission of the instructor.

SPN-351 Border Identities. V. Martinez. This course explores through essays, literature, and film the representations of Mexican culture along the border with United States. It examines cultural icons including Malinche, the Virgin of Guadalupe, border “saints”, Pancho Villa, Selena, etc. Representative texts will be selections from Chicano literature as well as selections from Mexican writers from Mexican Border states.
