BUILD INTELLECTUAL FOUNDATIONS

First-Year Preceptorial or **Honors First-Year Preceptorial** engages you in the exploration of ideas and diverse perspectives through critical reading, thinking, and writing. First-year students will be assigned to an FPR section one term during their first year. FPR will not be credited toward any major or minor.

Sophomore Research Seminar or **Scholars Research Seminar** ensures you have an early hands-on experience thinking and working as an academic researcher. In the spring of their first year, students will express their preferences for an SRS section, and will be assigned to an SRS in one term during their sophomore year. (Note that Union Scholars take their Scholars Research Seminar in their first year.) SRS will not be credited toward any major or minor.

Literature (HUL) expands the moral imagination needed to understand yourself and your fellow human beings through literary analysis, interpretation, and reflection. Any course from EGL, MLT, or any courses listed in the course schedule as HUL.

Natural Sciences with Lab (SCLB) changes the way you think about the natural world when you understand the scientific method and put it to work. Any Lab course in AST, BCH, BIO, CHM, ENS, GEO, PHY, and PSY-210 (depending on term) or PSY-312.

Quantitative and Mathematical Reasoning (QMR) equips you with unique insights and skills necessary to solve complex problems. Any course from MTH (except MTH-100) or any courses listed in the course schedule as QMR.

EXPLORE THE LIBERAL ARTS

Humanities (HUM) enable you to find yourself and your voice in creative expression and the exploration of works of the imagination. Any course from AAH, AMU, ATH, AVA, CLS, EGL, GRK, LAT, PHL, or courses offered by the Department of Modern Languages and Literatures.

Social Sciences (SOCS) confront you with the complexity and challenges of our world by analyzing the societies we create. Any course from ANT, ECO, HST, PSC, SOC, or PSY-100.

Science, Engineering and Technology (SET) introduces you to Union's unique commitment to teaching Science and Engineering as Liberal Arts and examining their impact on our humanity. Any science (lab or no), Engineering, CSC, or any courses listed in the course schedule as SET.

CREATE CONNECTIONS ACROSS BOUNDARIES

Linguistic and Cultural Competency (LCC) empowers you as a citizen of a global community to contribute across cultural boundaries and shape our shared future. Approved Study Abroad, or any two courses listed in the course schedule as LCC. Also, any two courses in the same language coded as LCCA (Arabic), LCCB (Biblical Greek) LCCC (Chinese), LCCF (French), LCCG (German), LCCH (Hebrew), LCCK (Greek), LCCJ (Japanese), LCCL (Latin), LCCR (Russian), LCCS (Spanish).

Writing Across the Curriculum (WAC) courses encourage you to explore and create your own understanding of the liberal arts through your writing. <http://www.union.edu/Resources/Academic/WAC/index.php>. Five WAC credits in at least two Divisions and Senior Writing Experience (WS).

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

Practicum Courses – (Fees applicable): One course credit is optionally available for participation after three terms of a practica: Ceramics, Choir, Dance, Ensembles, Instrumental lessons, Orchestra, Theater, and Vocal lessons. MULTIPLE SECTION COURSES/LABS: SPECIAL NOTE TO ALL STUDENTS SIGNING UP FOR COURSES WHICH HAVE MULTIPLE SECTIONS: Due to the possibility of over and under enrollments in certain sections of multiple section courses or lab sections, the Registrar’s Office, at the request of department chairs, may switch students out of their originally scheduled courses in order to balance the sections.

Fourth Course Policy

The annual tuition at Union allows a student to register for three terms taking three courses per term. This allows students to complete the required 36 courses for graduation. In some engineering programs as many as 40 courses may be required and those students are permitted to enroll in 10 courses per year. Under certain circumstances students may be allowed to take a fourth course in a term.

Students who are making satisfactory progress in their program of study are allowed to enroll in one fourth course during an academic year at no extra charge, provided they have a GPA of at least 3.3. These courses can be used to enhance the student's academic experience at Union. All such courses will appear on the transcript and can be used to fulfill program requirements; however, **they cannot be used for the purpose of accelerated graduation.** (This includes fourth courses taken on a Term Abroad.)

Fourth courses can also be used to make up a deficiency in credits due to withdrawals or failure. A 4th course fee will be charged under these circumstances. Students whose GPA is below 2.5 will need the written permission from Dean Wunderlich before signing up for a fourth course.

ALL students, INCLUDING ENGINEERING STUDENTS, with the exception of Leadership in Medicine (LIM) and Scholar Students, will be required to fill out the "Petition to Enroll in a Fourth Course" form. CROSS REGISTRATION

Please Note: Union College and *Union Graduate College are two separate Colleges. All graduate level courses taken by Union undergraduates, including Leadership in Medicine and Combined Degree students will be taken through Union Graduate College and will require completion of a special “Union Graduate College” Cross Registration Form. These forms are available in the Registrar’s Office in Silliman Hall.

Cross Registration has been a service of the Member Institutions of the Hudson Mohawk Association since 1970, when the Association was chartered by the New York State Board of Regents. *****DESCRIPTIONS OF COURSES NOT IN THE 2013-2014 ACADEMIC REGISTER*****

****Includes Revised Course Descriptions****

BNG-335 Polymeric Biomaterials. S. Khetan. This course focuses on the use of polymeric biomaterials for biomedical applications. Topics include, but are not limited to, basic polymer theory and characterization, the design and functionalization of novel polymers, processing techniques to fabricate polymeric scaffolds with desired micro- and macroscopic structures, the interactions of human cells and tissues with these materials, and the use of synthetic polymers to control the delivery of therapeutic molecules and as scaffolding materials for regenerative medicine applications. The course will also include an ethics module to discuss topical regulatory and/or ethical issues related to the field (e.g., the use of human embryonic stem cells in combination with polymeric scaffolds for regenerative applications).

CHM-245 Environmental Analytical Chemistry. L. MacManus-Spencer. This is a course focused on the role of chemical principles such as equilibrium, kinetics and molecular structure in understanding natural environmental cycles and the impacts of human activity on those cycles. Topics covered include: soil chemistry and the effects of agriculture; the fate of toxic organic chemicals in the environment; aquatic chemistry, water pollution and water treatment; atmospheric chemistry and air pollution; and energy and climate change. Prerequisite: CHM-231.

GER-110 Accelerated First-Year German. E. Nelson. This course is a condensed version of GER-100 and GER-101.

IDM-200 Brain/Mind/Soul. C. Chabris. A seminar led by students (with faculty supervision) that will address interdisciplinary topics related to the brain, the mind, and the soul. Sample discussion topics include the mind-body relationship, the nature and meaning of mental illness, the neuroscience of yoga and exercise, and the relationship between poverty and brain function. Students will engage with readings as well as a diverse group of Union professors and outside speakers. Admission to the course is by application only (apply by filling out the form at: <http://brainmindsoul.org/apply/>)

MTH-164 Strategies of Experimentation. R. Hoerl. Experimentation is at the heart of the scientific method, both in the physical and social sciences. Not only do experiments validate or disprove existing hypotheses, but often unexpected results lead to the development of new hypotheses and new theoretical understanding. This course will focus on strategies to accelerate the scientific method when experimenting with multiple variables. Specific topics include design options, such as simple comparative experiments, factorials and fractional factorials, and response surface designs, as well as analysis methods such as graphics, analysis of variance, and regression models. A course project, including choice of a design suitable to the objectives of the study, conducting the actual experiment, and then analyzing the results to derive conclusions, is an integral part of the course. Familiarity with basic statistics is assumed.

PSC-206 Politics of Modern South Asia. Y. Biberman. This course offers an in-depth and critical look at four important countries. A rising economic powerhouse and the world's largest democracy, India is a crucial state in contemporary South Asia and in global politics. The fate of India is intricately connected to that of Pakistan, its birth twin and nuclear rival. The domestic and international politics of Pakistan cannot be fully understood independent of the role of Bangladesh, which separated from Pakistan following a bloody civil war, and Afghanistan – a country undergoing profound transformation, with implications for domestic, regional, and international security. The topics covered will range from the partitioning of India and the birth of Pakistan, to the further partitioning in 1971 which led to the birth of Bangladesh, to the political processes that shape Afghanistan, and to the emergence of India as an influential member of the BRICS. Students will apply social science reasoning to analyze the major puzzles and policy issues that confront South Asia and the rest of the world.

PSC-207 Politics of the Arab Spring. M. Elghoul. The popular uprisings first initiated in Tunisia in December 2010 and still being fought in Syria and elsewhere, have forever altered the politics of the Middle East. This course is intended to provide a comparative overview of the recent uprisings in the Middle East, and the political, social, and economic contexts that have surrounded them. The readings in this fluctuating field will center on relevant contemporary literature, which the assignments will require students to further develop their analytical skills pertinent to the social sciences in general. Alongside questions that are specific to each revolt, this course will consider a number of over-arching questions: When do popular uprisings against authoritarianism work and when do they become democratic? How were non-violent methods employed and what led to violence? How can we characterize the role of social media, and did it differ in the varying contexts? Can connections be made between the Arab uprisings and other contemporary social movements?

PSC-257 The Global Rise of BRIC's. Y. Biberman. The BRICS – Brazil, Russia, India, China, and South Africa – are a new breed of economic giants. They are now the main source of economic growth in the world, and are projected soon to dominate the world economy as did Europe and the United States before them. While the BRICS countries are deemed similar when it comes to their economic success, they also exhibit remarkable political and social diversity. The course investigates the BRICS countries' rise influence the existing international system? How do we know whether a country is "rising"? What underlies economic development? What is the relationship between development, democracy, and security? Do the BRICS countries represent a new recipe for development in the twenty-first century? If so, what is this recipe?

PSC-339 Seminar: Interpretations of Antigone, Medea, Cassandra. L. Marso. (cross-listed with WGS-495)

This course explores readings of female figures appearing in classical texts who reappear and are reinterpreted into the present. Our primary figures will include Penelope (from Homer's *Odyssey*), Cassandra (Homer's *Iliad*), Medea (multiple sources, but our original will be Euripides), and Antigone (Sophocles). After reading the classical texts, or excerpts from them, we will jump forward in history as these same women are continually reinvented and reinserted into new narratives and new histories with vastly varying implications. Our focus will be on reading practices: how do we understand what is at stake in how female figures are painted as powerful, passive, manipulative, cunning, or sympathetic? How are our readings informed by our own times and political sympathies? This will be a course with diverse "texts" with theory, literature, and film as the primary sources.

PSC-363 Law and Social Movements. K. Zuber. This course examines the constitutive relationship between law and social movements. Specifically, we will consider how courts, legal rights and legal institutions shape the development of American social movements – and vice versa. The course has three goals. First, students will be introduced to general theories regarding the lifecycle of a movement including the emergence, development, and the decline of social movements over time. A second goal of this course will be to describe and understand the legal strategies pursued by various social movement constituencies, as well as the factors that influence the selection of legal strategies. Specifically, we will concentrate on activity stemming from both the Civil Rights and Gay Rights Movements. Finally, a closely related goal of this course is to explore how legal institutions and actors shape – and are shaped – by their engagement with social movements. How do legal institutions and actors respond to the demands of social movement constituencies and to what extent are movements themselves shaped by their interactions with the law?

PSY-440 Seminar: Human Development. L. Stanhope. In this seminar we will consider issues faced by parents and children in today's world. Analyses of case studies and in-depth discussion of current research will be emphasized. Choice of topics will depend largely on the interests of the students in the class. Sample topics include: divorce/remarriage/stepfamilies; coping with a parent's death; gay and lesbian parenting; adoption; bullies, mean girls & victims; cross-cultural parenting issues; influence of T.V. or video games; child abuse; siblings/birth order; day care and working mothers; handicapped children; children's fears and coping styles; childhood stress and suicide; hurrying children to grow up too soon (e.g. Toddlers and Tiaras!) **Prerequisite: Developmental Psychology.**

REL-280 Religion and Science. K. Wegter-McNelly. This course explores the historical and contemporary relations between the world's religions and the sciences. The presently pervasive "conflict" view is examined, along with alternative views. The course assumes no background in science beyond high school, nor adherence to any religious tradition. The course's basic goals are 1) to introduce students to a broad range of topics relevant to the relation between religion and science in contemporary culture; 2) to examine and assess several typologies for mapping out the relations between religion and science; 3) to explore the history of these relations, the role of philosophy in contemporary discussions, the views of science espoused within various religious traditions, as well as various areas of intersection such as cosmic origins, intelligent design, human cognition, environmental well-being, and genomics; and 4) to evaluate various contemporary claims made about the relations between scientific and religious accounts of reality and to have students develop their own views.

SOC-262 Juvenile Delinquency. T. Stablein. This course offers an overview of sociological theory and research concerning juvenile delinquency, youth crime, and youth culture. The course analyzes the causes of juvenile delinquency. It evaluates current strategies to control delinquency, such as incarceration, treatment, and rehabilitation, as well as the historic role and effectiveness of the juvenile justice and criminal justice systems in that pursuit. This course will also focus on understanding what influences ways of thinking about youth crime and delinquency in society. We will critically evaluate these perceptions and the role they play in shaping policies and strategies to control delinquency in society. In addition, the course considers the strategies young people have historically employed to counter situations of deprivation and feelings of alienation and the forces which shape outcomes.

SPN-308T Spain's History and Culture Through Film. P. Moyano. How does a country come to define itself as such? What diverse elements merge together to form a national and cultural identity? This course will study the development and construction of Spanish culture mainly through film. Specifically, we will examine the cultural threads of distinct identities that have been woven together throughout history to visibly influence the design of contemporary Spanish society. Far from viewing peninsular culture as a seamless, cohesive entity, we will consider the conflicts between dominant and marginalized groups such as men/women, Castilians/non-Castilians, and Christians/Jews/Arabs as crucial forces in the shaping of Spanish identity. Our analyses in this course will question to what extent the concept of Spanishness has been shaped as a reaction against a foreign other, whether that "other" dwells outside or inside the borders of Spain itself. *Prerequisites: Two 300-level courses.*

SPN-407 Cultures in Contact (and Conflict). S. Mueller. What does it mean to be a national of a country? And who is included in that definition? By analyzing the specific case of Spain, in this course we will discover that the answers to these questions are complex and multiple. We will study literature, film, music, and television shows from three culturally and linguistically distinct regions of Spain: Galicia, Catalonia, and the Basque Country. In our analyses of these works we will discuss the key components of national identity, including language, traditions, geography, historical memory, political repression and violence, and gender. In the final unit we will explore how immigration and Spain's relationship to the European Union are challenging traditional definitions of the nation.

WGS-495 Capstone: Interpretations of Antigone, Medea, Cassandra. (Cross-listed with PSC-339).
