DESCRIPTION OF COURSES NOT IN THE 2016-17 ACADEMIC REGISTER

Includes Revised Course Descriptions

AAH-218 Leonardo Da Vinci. L. Matthew. This course explores the history of science and technology during a fascinating and complex period when "modern" sciences and engineering are just beginning to emerge in Europe. Our focus will be on the artist and thinker Leonardo da Vinci, whose writings, drawings, and other works of art provide a vivid picture of the state of imagination, observation, and the pursuit of scientific and technical knowledge, both theoretical and practical, during a time of great change. CC: HUM

ADA-041 The Moving Body Practicum. M. Moutillet. class will focus on the study of a fusion of dance styles to provide a welcoming class to our dancers or non-dancers at Union College. Taught to music, this technique dance class will include some contemporary dance vocabulary, a study of muscular elongation of the body and the development of one's physical potential. Special emphasis will be given to proper warm up, awareness of body isolation and placement in order to enhance endurance and flexibility. Open to all interested in learning and experiencing the fundamentals of the dance discipline.

AMU-284 Mozart's Letters and Music. D. McMullen. The name is Joannes Chrysostomus Wolfgangus Theophilus Mozart. This is quite a start for a prodigy! Through Mozart's correspondence students will learn about his thoughts, ambitions, personality, character strengths and weaknesses, relationships with others, and ideals. At the same time students will trace his development as a composer from age 5 through his death at age 35, focusing primarily on the genres of keyboard music, symphonies, opera, and sacred works. Students who read German will have the opportunity to work with digital copies of letters in Mozart's handwriting, thereby learning to decipher late eighteenth-century German handwriting. Music majors and minors will study some scores in detail, assisted by directed writing assignments. All students will gain a solid understanding of Mozart's musical style. This course is open to all students, regardless of major. CC: HUM

ANT-233 Multiculturalism: Race, Religion and the Nation State. A. Khan. How to deal with cultural diversity has become one of the most central and polarizing issues in contemporary nation-states, especially as immigration has introduced new forms of cultural difference in terms of race, ethnicity and religion. Multiculturalism has emerged as one of the key strategies for managing cultural diversity in contemporary nation-states. While some see multiculturalism as the basis for a more inclusive, equal and tolerant society, others see it as creating cultural division and barriers, and still others see it as a threat to the core cultural values that give order and coherence to the nation. In this class, we examine the politics surrounding "culture" in the nation-state and the paradoxes of multiculturalism. We ask what how cultural diversity is and how it is managed in contemporary nation-states. Does multiculturalism benefit ethnic, racial and religious minorities or does it undermine the basis for the nation-state? What are the achievements and limits of multiculturalism in addressing the problems of cultural diversity in the modern nation-state? How can we get beyond multiculturalism to a true recognition of the value of cultural diversity?

BNG-335 Polymeric Biomaterials. S. Khetan. This course focuses on the use of polymeric biomaterials for biomedical applications. Topics include, but are not limited to, basic polymer theory and characterization, the design and functionalization of novel polymers, processing techniques to fabricate polymeric scaffolds with desired micro- and macroscopic structures, the interactions of human cells and tissues with these materials, and the use of synthetic polymers to control the delivery of therapeutic molecules and as scaffolding materials for regenerative medicine applications. The course will also include an ethics module to discuss topical regulatory and/or ethical issues related to the field (e.g., the use of human embryonic stem cells in combination with polymeric scaffolds for regenerative applications). Prerequisite: BNG-201 or MER-201.

CLS-140 Introduction to Greek Archaeology. A. Commito. For thousands of years, the Aegean has been home to dynamic societies whose complex interactions with each other and with the broader region produced some of the most distinctive cultural and political achievements of the ancient world. This course introduces students to the physical remains these societies left behind. We study key concepts of Greek archaeology, including issues of chronology and ethics, as well as major themes in the study of the ancient Greek world, such as religion and the emergence of the city-state. Special attention is paid to new developments in archaeological research methods, such as paleoethnobotany, isotopic analysis, geophysical prospection, and aerial photogrammetry using drones. We begin around 3000 BCE with the rise of the region's first complex civilizations, and end around 100 BCE with the transformations brought about by the conquests of Alexander the Great. Along the way, we explore how archaeological investigations reveal the distinctiveness of ancient Greece and help us reconstruct the daily lives of people in antiquity. CC: HUM

ECE-371 High Resolution Radar. C. Pappu. Introducing the concepts on the basic theory for design and analysis of radar systems. Radar signal processing, signal design, high resolution, and providing Range and Doppler information. Prerequisites: ECE 241.

ECO-232 Current Issues in U.S. Health Care. J. Gao. This course uses basic economic concepts (such as law of supply/demand, the competitive model, market failure, and public goods) to study issues in the health care market. The goal is to demonstrate how economists think about health care issues and policies. We will cover a number of topics including the demand for health and health care, U.S. health care system and health care spending, public health insurance programs, government interventions in health related behaviors, and health care reform. Prerequisite: ECO-101.

FLM-375 Free Form Filmmaking. J. deSeve. Do research and experimentation in documentary, fiction filmmaking, video art installations, music videos, experimental film or other styles. This hands-on production course allows students the freedom to work in the style of their choosing while receiving guidance on filmmaking form and technique. A final screening of all works produced during the term will be held for the campus community.

GEO-309 The Dating Game: Geochronology. H.Frey & J. Garver. The goal of this course is to familiarize students with the techniques and application of radiometric dating. This includes understanding radioactive decay, unstable isotopes, and how radioactive isotopes occur in the environment. It will introduce students to various dating methods from U-Pb and $^{40}\text{Ar}/^{39}\text{Ar}$ to ^{10}Be and ^{14}C dating. Students will gain an understanding of why these different radiometric systems are used in calculating a rock date and how different systems result in different ages of dated material. The course will introduce concepts/methods and illustrate them with case studies from the literature. This course includes a lab component and term project in which a rock sample will be processed to extract zircons, characterized with various imaging techniques, and U-Pb dated with laser ablation mass spectrometry. An introductory geology class is a pre-requisite.

HST-293 History of Medicine. P. Singy. This course offers a survey of the history of medicine in the Western world from the ancient Greeks to the present. We will consider several key moments in this history, such as the so-called "Greek miracle" in medicine (Hippocrates), the discovery of blood circulation (William Harvey), and the invention of bacteriology (Louis Pasteur and Robert Koch). In the last two class sessions we will focus more specifically on the history of psychiatry. All the class readings are primary sources.

LAS 202: Oil and Revolution in Latin America and the Caribbean . J. García. The course will examine that parallel rise of petroleum exploration in Latin America and the Caribbean and multinational corporations as discoveries of large deposits of petroleum (oil) are made in countries in the early stages of instability and full revolution in the twentieth century. It will also examine the rise of state-owned oil companies during the early part of the twentieth century and the development of a coordinated U.S. foreign policy led by, in some cases multinational corporations. How these state-owned oil companies emerged and spread throughout the hemisphere in the 1920/30s and remain important today as well as controversial. The time span for this course is roughly from 1895 to current worldwide petroleum debates, conflicts, and policies that challenge the historical dominance of multinational petroleum companies. The regions of specific study will include those countries that are rich in energy resources and have engaged in reform and revolutionary processes that in some cases openly defied U.S. foreign policy and multinational control of resources. The comparative nature of the course follows the historical sociology of pre-World War II and Cold War and post war periods that examines the changing dynamics of the geopolitical history of petroleum and its strategic importance in Latin America and the Caribbean. Special attention will also be given to the rise of regional and international organizations that were influenced by the development of revolutions and state-owned oil companies.

Oil and Revolution is a study of the geopolitical conflicts surrounding the world's most sought after resource and an important yet neglected study in Latin American and Caribbean Studies (LACS) Program at Union College. A natural resource topic in LACS but also in other disciplines. It provides **a)** a set of critical tools for understanding the historical sociology of petroleum relations in region; **b)** a methods and skills course pertinent to examining the history, sociology and politics of the crisis that petroleum creates; and **c)** a set of reflexive and critical coordinates useful in understanding institutional processes responsible for the development of natural resource policies in LAC during the 20th and 21st centuries. Consult with the current LACS director or your advisor(s) prior to considering your options in order to ascertain the course's relevance and recognition within your area(s) of study. CC: LCC, HUM.

HST-294 Crime and Punishment in America. Riley. In colonial America, practicing witchcraft was against the law. Beating your wife was not. Convicted wrongdoers faced hangings, flogging, even branding - but not prison. There has always been crime and punishment in America, but just what counts as a crime, which crimes are committed, which are especially dreaded, how criminals are prosecuted, who they are, and what kinds of penalties they face has changed from century to century. In this course, we will explore the social and cultural roots of crime and criminal punishment and, just as important, the changing ways in which both were defined and perceived.

MLT-257 Media and Gender in Japan. D. Johnson. In this course we will examine how issues of gender are raised through popular media and cultural forms in Japan. This will include film, television, popular music, games, and even internet based media. Our investigation into gender and media will include matters of representation in dramatic and image based media, but we will also consider some of the ways in which audiences have organized themselves through acts of consumption and participation in media culture. Furthermore, the relationship between the character driven media culture of Japan, aesthetics of cuteness, and various forms of media genre and performance will also help shape our approach to the media environment specific to Japan. Topics will include gendered modernity in the 1930s, “trendy” television dramas and audience fragmentation during the 1990s, and how celebrity has helped to mediate matters of gender and fantasy throughout the twentieth and early twenty first centuries. CC: HUM, HUL

PHL-244 Plato’s Republic. K. Scheiter. Most people agree that justice is good thing and we should strive to be just. But what is justice? And why do we think we ought to be just? What if we always do the right thing, but someone spreads a rumor that we are untrustworthy? Should we still be just even if everyone things we are dishonest and corrupt? Or is justice still worth pursuing for itself? If justice is good how do we make our cities just? Who should rule these just cities? In this course we will try to answer these questions as we work our way through Plato’s most famous work, the *Republic*. Each class will be organized around specific question(s). We will focus most of our attention on analyzing and interpreting Plato’s answer to these questions. But we will also try to answer these questions ourselves and see whether or not we agree with Plato. No prerequisites. CC: HUM

PHL-263 Feminism. K. Tullman. This course covers philosophical topics in feminism, women’s studies, and gender studies. We will focus on three major themes and related questions: 1) the nature of sexual oppression, 2) the social construction of gender, sexuality, and identity and 3) power dynamics that contribute to sexual oppression and sexual identity. We will focus on these three issues and how they relate to “everyday oppression”—microaggressions (seemingly insignificant or harmless instances of sexism, homophobia, racism, etc.) and how they both reflect and contribute to microaggressions (significant, important, “newsworthy” instances of sexism, homophobia, racism, etc.). While most of the readings are by contemporary philosophers, we will also consider work from other disciplines, such as sociology and literary theory. No prerequisites. CC: HUM

PHL-316 Indian Philosophy 2: Ways of Knowing. D. Nowakowski. This course examines the debates between Buddhist intellectuals and their rivals in two Hindu philosophical traditions, the Nyaya and the Mimamsa, which dominated Indian philosophy from roughly the 6th to the 12th centuries CE. Through close study of the primary texts in translation, we will explore their theories of the ways by which human beings can know the world. We will then see how these Indian philosophers apply their theories of knowledge and good reasoning to a variety of disputed questions about the existence of God, the self, reincarnation, and the structure of the external world. No prior experience with Indian or Asian philosophy or religion is assumed or expected. However, given the challenging nature of the texts, some prior work in philosophy (whether eastern or western) would be a very good idea! No prerequisites. CC: HUM

PSC-242 Democracies and Immigration in the 21st Century: Inclusion, Exclusion, and Citizenship. Y. Hsieh. Immigration shook recent European politics at the local, national and EU levels. In March 2014, the National Front swept to victory in 12 French cities as a champion of anti-immigration messages. Two months later, the National Front secured another electoral victory in the European Parliament Election. Chancellor Angela Merkel's handling of the refugee issue contributed to her Christian Democrat Party's serious setback in the March 2016 regional elections. In retrospect, many British voters seemed to have expressed their unease about immigration through casting ballots in the 2016 Brexit referendum.

The increasing polarization on immigration shocked many, because not long ago, politicians in many liberal democracies were able to weave immigration into the narratives of national self-understanding like a consensus. Former President Woodrow Wilson once said, "We came to America, either ourselves or in the persons of our ancestors, to better the ideals of men, to make them see finer things than they had seen before, to get rid of the things that divide and to make sure of the things that unite." On the contrary, many politicians in the post-WWII Federal Republic of Germany had for a long time insisted, "Germany is not a country of immigration" (Wir sind kein Einwanderungsland).

How does such national self-understanding influence today's immigration politics? To what extent do various discourses in the debates reflect immigration history and the trajectories of immigration policies? Amidst the climate of immigration debates during recent primary and general elections, how many Americans still pride themselves of the ethos of America being a "country of immigration" that harbors "the tired and the poor?" Inspired by these questions, this course discusses immigration politics from the perspective of citizenship ideas and national self-understanding. We focus on past and present immigration politics in selected liberal democracies, including France, Germany, Israel and the US. We pay special attention to labor migration, family reunification and international displacement. Prerequisites: PSC-111 or PSC-112 or sophomore standing required.

PSC-255 Russian Foreign Policy. A. Park. This course introduces students to Russian foreign policy, placing our analysis within an historical context. The course will consider the geographical and historical context of Russian foreign policy before the Bolshevik Revolution. Then we will examine Soviet foreign policy up to and including the collapse of the USSR in late 1991 and proceed with a focus on Russian foreign policy developments since the collapse. We will also address all vectors of Russian foreign policy toward different parts of the world, particularly the US, the EU, the "near abroad", and the Middle East. Finally, we will examine the role and use of petroleum products in Russia's foreign policy. Prerequisites: PSC-111 or PSC-112 or PSC-113 and sophomore standing required.

REL-202 Religion and Ecology: Historical and Contemporary Perspectives. K. Wegter-McNelly. What does religion have to do with the long-term health of life on Earth? Is it part of the problem, part of the solution, or both? What perspectives have different religions taken on specific environmental issues? This course examines the significance of both traditional and contemporary religious beliefs and activities for the ecological challenges and opportunities facing our world today. Religious attitudes toward the natural world, humanity's place within the natural world, and the ultimate destiny of human and non-human life have often formed and in many cases still shape people's attitudes toward the environment. Examples considered in the course are drawn from across the world's religious traditions and cultures. In the second half of the term small groups explore the ecological concerns of a particular religious group outside of class and present their findings to each other in class. The course ends by considering the value of interreligious dialogue for contemporary religious engagement with ecological issues. No prerequisites. CC: HUM

REL-282 Entanglement: Matter, Meaning and Mystery. K. Wegter-McNelly. Quantum entanglement is one of the most remarkable ideas to have emerged from the natural sciences in the twentieth century. Identified as a consequence of quantum theory already in the 1920s, it was confirmed as a physical phenomenon only in the 1980s. The broader implications of living in an "entangled" world are only beginning to be felt outside the walls of physics. This course explores the meaning of quantum entanglement and its potential significance for relational accounts of personhood, life, the cosmos, and God. It begins by exploring the turn to "relationality" in much contemporary religious thought. It then examines the history of the concept of "separateness" in modern physics from a philosophical perspective. Two weeks are devoted to an examination of Bell's Inequality, the basic formalism of quantum theory, and the quantum prediction in the case of Bell-type experiments. Returning to the realm of philosophy, the course then considers, in general, the longstanding debates over the ontological and epistemological significance of the empirical success of quantum theory, including the relatively recent empirical confirmation of entanglement. With this broad view of quantum entanglement in place, the final weeks of the term bring together the previously discussed topics for the sake of thinking alongside contemporary religious and theological writers about what the discovery of quantum entanglement means for the way we think about the physical world and our place in it. No prerequisites. CC: HUM

SOC-207 Sociology of African American Religious Experience. D. Hill-Butler. Sociology of African American Religious Experience examines the social constructions of traditions and practices of African American religious leaders and everyday practitioners. CC: LCC

SPN-307 Luchas Armadas: Violence and Rebellion in 20th Century Spain. D. Collinge. This course is an introduction to 20th century Spanish literature and culture with a focus on the problem of armed rebellion and political violence in Spain over the last hundred years. We will study texts from a variety of genres including narrative, drama, poetry, and film alongside an understanding of key historical circumstances and political concepts. Discussions in class will focus on literary and cultural texts in addition to readings that examine theories of war, violence and power, justice and the law, and historical memory. We will pay special attention to a particular group of actors: the police, the military, guerrilla fighters, anarchists, communists, separatists, nationalists, paramilitaries, terrorists, victims, survivors. As a result, we will explore the reciprocal relationship that has existed between armed conflict and Spanish democracy as well as the effects it continues to have on the present. Class discussions and writing assignments will be in Spanish, with the aim of strengthening critical thinking, reading, and writing skills. Keep in mind that this class is an exploration whose path will zigzag across disciplines, with the goal of raising questions rather than answering them.
