COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM

Courses numbered 0-49 carry no credit. Courses numbered 50-99 are designated for Common Curriculum or do not count for the major. Courses numbered 100-199 are all introductory level offerings. Courses numbered 200-299 are those at the sophomore/junior level that may also be taken by non-majors. Courses numbered 300-399 are upper-level that are primarily intended for majors, i.e., which represent the depth component of the major. Courses numbered 400-499 are all advanced level courses for seniors, including those used to fulfill the Senior Writing Experience (WS), seminars, research, thesis and independent studies.

DESCRIPTION OF COURSES NOT IN THE 2017-18 ACADEMIC REGISTER

Includes Revised Course Descriptions

AMU 222 Music and the Holocaust. Liu, P. This seminar views multiple aspects of the Holocaust through the lens of music. The period beginning in 1933 in which many musicians were gradually dismissed from orchestras and mainstream musical life in Europe is a rich subject of musical study. Music played a variety of roles ranging from bringing comfort to victims to providing material for Nazi propaganda videos. The diverse roles that music played in the lives of the victims of the Holocaust will be examined during the time stretching from the rise of the Third Reich to 1945, with a special emphasis on the organized events of the Jüdischer Kulturbund, Eastern Ghettos, and Concentration Camps. The ability to read music notation is not a prerequisite for this course.

ANT 255 Culture and Work. Kappeler, A. This course takes a broad perspective on the relationship between culture and work. Course readings, assignments and discussions, will prompt students to consider how work activities are shaped by culture and the larger social context by examining: i) institutional cultures involving idiosyncratic authority structures, routines, shared knowledge and so on; ii) how local cultures are influenced by their place in larger international production chains. **CC: LCC**

FLM 310 Environmental Action Media Lab. De Seve, J. This hands-on media production class challenges students to investigate and create media on environmental issues critical to Earth's survival. Students will also develop a plan to move audience members to substantive action on their issue(s). The course will culminate in a locally-sourced banquet at Proctor's Theatre in March 2018 in which the banquet food itself will serve as a platform for investigating the environmental impact of food and sustainability.

HST 202 African Women in History. Peterson, B. This course explores the history of women in Africa. It takes an historical approach to looking at the lives, experiences, stories, and changing roles of women across Africa. The course focuses heavily on the writings of African women, such as memoirs, novels, poetry, and political treatises.

HST 293 History of Medicine. Riley, J. This course offers a survey of the history of medicine in the Western world from the ancient Greeks to the present. We will consider several key moments in this history, such as the so-called "Greek miracle" in medicine (Hippocrates), the discovery of blood circulation (William Harvey), and the invention of bacteriology (Louis Pasteur and Robert Koch). At the end of the term we will focus more specifically on the history of psychiatry. All the readings are primary sources.

HST 294 Crime and Punishment in America. Singy, P. In colonial America, practicing witchcraft was against the law. Beating your wife was not. Convicted wrongdoers faced hangings, flogging, even branding--but not prison. There has always been crime and punishment in America, but just what counts as a crime, which crimes are committed, which are especially dreaded, how criminals are prosecuted, who they are, and what kinds of penalties they face has changed from century to century. In this course, we will explore the social and cultural roots of crime and criminal punishment and, just as important, the changing ways in which both were defined and perceived.

MER 431 Thermodynamics. Staff. This course builds upon the fundamental skills learned in Thermodynamics 1 and 2, and applies them to the real-world systems commonly used to convert heat and work. First, students will apply the tools of applied thermodynamics to actual power plant heat and mass balance diagrams to interpret them and understand "why things are the way they are." Students will then add new tools to their arsenal, including energy loss analysis, preliminary sizing of turbomachinery, and leveled cost of energy. In the second half of the course, we will survey emerging technologies in the field of thermodynamics, such as supercritical CO₂ power cycles, oxyfuel cycles with built-in carbon capture, heat-pump based energy storage, fuel cells, and magnetocaloric heat pumps. Students will apply the new skills they have learned to evaluate the cost/benefit of these new technologies and determine the "tipping point" at which these new technologies could disrupt conventional thermodynamic cycles and revolutionize our world.

PHL 288 Skepticism East and West. Nowakowski, D. For as long as there have been philosophers engaged in passionate pursuit of knowledge, there have been skeptics critical of the entire project. Can we really know the Truth about anything? For that matter, how important is it for us to know the Truth? Skeptical thinkers have appeared in all times and cultures. We will engage with the works of three important thinkers from around the world: Zhuangzi from ancient China, Nagarjuna's writings on the Buddhist Middle Way from ancient India, and the Outlines of Skepticism by Sextus Empiricus from ancient Greece. Our goal is to put these authors into dialogue and then join in that dialogue.

PSC 262 Race and U.S. Politics. Plencner, J. This course is designed as a broad introduction to the role of race in US politics, from the founding of the American republic through the present day. Though fundamentally concerned with politics, political processes, and governing institutions, the course examines questions regarding race, ethnicity, and power that routinely cross disciplinary boundaries. By drawing on readings from political science, history, policy and legal studies, as well as popular culture, mainstream media, and documentary films, students will situate and account for race within what mid-20th century American writer James Baldwin once described as "the story of America"—which he cautioned "is not a very pretty story." By engaging with the politics of race expansively, and wrestling with ideas that represent a variety of political commitments and perspectives, the goal of the course is for students to develop a nuanced picture of how Americans have understood race in the past, how racial meaning has shifted through law and policy discourses over time, and how the defense of, accommodation for, and struggle against racial and ethnic oppression is fundamentally constitutive of the American political experience. Prerequisite: PSC-111, PSC-112 or sophomore standing required.

PSC 346 Technologies: Power, Politics and Society across Industrial Revolutions. Dallas, M. With the advent of the internet, robotics, Big Data, artificial intelligence and machine learning, we are already well into a Third (some say 'Fourth') Industrial Revolution. If history is any guide, this industrial revolution is transforming society, politics and culture in ways both overt and subtle. Further, as it diffuses, it will not be replicated identically across time and space. This course compares the first, second and third industrial revolutions – selectively focusing on the advent of factories/machines, mass production and information technologies, respectively. For each revolution, the course asks three questions 1) how value is created, 2) who controls and benefits from the new modes of production and consumption, and 3) how it transforms and is transformed by its social and political contexts. Second, it explores variation across different national political economies, most prominently in the advanced countries of England, the US, Europe and Japan, with selective comparisons to other developing countries. Prerequisite: PSC-111, PSC-112 or sophomore standing required.

PSC 369 Seminar in US Politics: Partisanship in the United States. Oxley, Z. For many Americans, partisanship is one of their most salient of political identities. In this seminar we will explore the sources of party identification, the reasons why some citizens choose to identify as independent of a party, and the consequences of viewing the world through a partisan lens, such as the biased processing of new information and polarization. Our focus will extend beyond members of the public to include topics such as the origins of the contemporary Democratic and Republican parties and challenges facing both parties. We will also devote significant attention to whether and when the two main parties have attempted to incorporate members of politically marginalized groups (e.g., women, racial and ethnic minorities, young voters).

SOC 208/BIO 060 Social Identities & Science in the Genomic Age. Hill-Butler, D. Danowski, B. Is race genetically determined? Do men and women have different brains? Is genetic ancestry testing a form of racial profiling? Should race, gender and sexuality be considered during human clinical trials? What are the pros and cons of race-based medicine? This course will focus on two related (reciprocal) questions: Do cultural understandings of race & gender influence how science is done AND do scientific results and/or the interpretations of those results change our cultural understandings of race and gender either to reinforce misconceptions or to erode them? In an interactive lecture format we will approach race and gender as biosocial constructs, exploring their roles in debates about the relationship between biology and society, nature & culture, and human similarity & difference. We will place these debates in their historical context, as we examine how cultural understandings and misunderstandings of race, gender, and difference influenced and continue to influence scientific inquiry. Next we will investigate how the sequencing of the human genome has shaped contemporary scientific questions related to genetic diversity, sexuality and gender. Simultaneously we will deepen our understanding of cells, genetics, genomic diversity and DNA technologies during the lab portion of the course by performing some of the techniques currently used to compare individuals' genomes. CC:SCLB

SPN 405 Lost and Found in Translation. (Same as MLT 301) Osuna, M. This course introduces advanced students of Spanish to the field of Translation and Interpretation Studies, and offers practical approaches for the acquisition of translation skills. It aims at broadening and refining students' linguistic competence, and sharpening analytical and critical abilities. The course provides a foundation for further studies in Translation and Interpretation as well as a basic preparation for employment that may require translation skills. Class will be taught in Spanish. **CC:** WAC, HUM, LCC.
