As you know, the College plans to host outdoor (rain or shine), in-person Commencement celebrations for the Class of 2021 at 10 a.m. on June 13, 2021 and for the Class of 2020 at 10 a.m. on June 20, 2021. Both ceremonies will take place on Roger Hull Plaza in front of Schaffer Library. Faculty will robe at their offices or homes and find their seats in the faculty section and be seated by 9:30 a.m. Only the platform party will process. During the recessional, faculty will follow the platform party to recess to Rugby Field. Note that, due to New York State health and safety requirements, the faculty seating area will differ from normal for this year's events. It will not be under the Lippman Hall or the Karp Hall colonnades but behind the graduates, spaced six feet apart. The post-Commencement academic department and program gatherings will be held at various outdoor locations across campus where smaller groups of graduates, faculty, staff and ticketed guests will be able to visit and take pictures. We will provide more information about this in the coming weeks. In compliance with current NYS guidelines on end-of-year academic celebrations, diplomas will be handed out centrally at the commencement location, rather than at the post-ceremony gatherings.

Baccalaureate Commemorations will be virtual this year. Stay tuned for further details.

These two celebrations cap an extraordinarily challenging and demanding fifteen months for our students and faculty alike. Your participation in the commencement festivities means a great deal to the students. For many of them, this is a last chance to say goodbye to faculty members who have been an important part of their lives and an opportunity to introduce you to their families. In surveys of the classes of 2020 and 2021, both classes emphasized a strong desire to connect with and thank their faculty as one of the biggest reasons they wanted an in-person celebration. I join them in appreciation for your participation in these events.

Caps and gowns will be available from the Campus Bookstore. For junior faculty, there will be no charge for cap and gown rental but there is a \$40 charge for hood rental. For senior faculty, there is a charge of \$40 for cap and gown rental, and another \$40 for hood rental. needs to place the order by Friday, May 14. Please note that there is no requirement that one wear a hood in an academic procession.
