### Electronic Student Account Access

The Bursar's office uses electronic billing and provides student account information to students and parents through Union College Self Service. Student access to Self Service is through its **WebAdvising** student menu. Billing and payment information is updated hourly, daily and weekly.

Students should grant their parents access to their Self Service account so both students and parents receive email alerts about billing and payment due dates. Parents granted access can log into **Self Service Portal** at any time to view billing material from the current or previous academic terms. #### MONTHLY PAYMENT OPTIONS

#### FLYWIRE (INTERNATIONAL TRANSACTIONS)

International students: Pay at your local bank, in your home currency, with no wire or bank transfer fees, and receive a lower exchange rate using **Flywire**. This payment portal is the preferred method of payment for all international transactions. Once an account is set up with Flywire, students can conveniently use their account to pay and receive refunds for Union College.

## ADMISSIONS DEPOSITS

Admissions deposits will be credited to student accounts before the fall bill has been applied.

## STUDENT HEALTH INSURANCE

Union College requires all students to have health insurance coverage. All students are billed for the health insurance with the fall bill. Once billed, all domestic students must **enroll in or waive** the Student Health Insurance plan by Sept. 15. The amount billed for health insurance will be removed from your account upon successful submission of the online waiver form. Before you waive the college insurance plan, it is recommended that you review your current insurance plan to be sure you have adequate coverage while in Schenectady. You must upload your active insurance card when waiving the college insurance. Visit **Haylor, Freyer & Coon** for more information. Please note that you must enroll or waive annually.

International students are automatically enrolled in and billed for the annual insurance plan.

## BILLING

Once per term, the Bursar's office bills for the full comprehensive fee (tuition, room and board). An email will be sent to all students to inform them that their account has been updated with a bill. An email will also be sent to any persons granted permission by the student through **Self Service**.

Incidental charges (bookstore, dining, health services, etc.) are added to the student account weekly and are due net 30.

## LATE PAYMENT POLICY

A late fee of \$100 is charged for all late payments.

Students with an outstanding balance may not:

- pre-schedule classes for the next term
- apply to terms abroad
- request or receive transcripts
- receive degrees/diplomas

In extreme cases, students may be withdrawn from Union.

## FINANCIAL AID

Financial aid is applied to student accounts after the necessary documentation has been submitted, verified, and the student has accepted the aid.

If your award(s) is shown as "currently ineligible" on the student statement after the trimester has begun, please contact the Financial Aid Office to resolve the issue.
