UNION COLLEGE DEBARMENT CERTIFICATION FORM

PURPOSE

Federal regulations prohibit participants in federal non-procurement transactions from purchasing goods and services from organizations excluded from participation in federal programs due to debarment or suspension. These regulations are implemented under Executive Order 12549, Debarment and Suspension, 2 CFR Part 180. The Certification below must be returned to Union College from which it originated. The form requires you to certify that neither your firm nor principals of the firm are debarred or suspended from participating in federal non-procurement transactions.

The Contractor certifies that, neither the Contractor firm nor any owner, partner, director, officer, or principal of the Contractor, nor any person in a position with management responsibility or responsibility for the administration of federal funds:

- (a) Is presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, and declared ineligible or voluntarily excluded from covered transactions by any federal or state department/agency;
- (b) Is presently indicted for or otherwise criminally or civilly charged by a governmental entity (federal, state, or local) with commission of any of the offenses enumerated in paragraph (b) above; or
- (c) Has within a three-year period preceding this certification had one or more public transactions or contracts (federal, state, or local) terminated for cause or default.

(d) The contractor is "Actively" registered w	with SAMS (Service for Award Management), and
has been assigned the following UEI #:	·

The Contractor further certifies that it shall not knowingly enter into any transaction with any subcontractor, material supplier, or vendor who is debarred, suspended, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from covered transactions by any federal or state department/agency.
