

Student Right-to-Know Act Graduation/Completion Rate Report

The following information about graduation/completion rates is provided in compliance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended. The rates reflect the graduation/completion status of students who enrolled during the fall term of the 2008-09 academic year and for whom 150% of the normal time-to-completion of a four-year, undergraduate degree has elapsed.

- 1 Graduation rates are based on a cohort of full-time, first-time, first-year students and do not include students who have transferred into the college from another institution.
- 2 The incoming cohort may be adjusted for students who left school to serve in the armed forces or on official church missions or with foreign aid service of the federal government, or students who died or were totally and permanently disabled.
- 3 Because providing substantial preparation for students to enroll in other institutions is not part of the college's mission, transfer-out rates are not calculated.
- 4 Data by financial aid category is a good faith effort to comply with the Higher Education Act provision that became effective in August 2008.
