Interdepartmental majors will normally take eight courses in psychology that must include Psychology 100 (Introduction), Psychology 200 (Statistics) and one course numbered 300 through 451 (Graduating classes of 2020, and 2021 exempt). Students wishing to do an interdepartmental senior thesis will also take Psychology 300 (Experimental) prior to starting the thesis. *An interdepartmental thesis is a requirement for honors.* The senior thesis may count for one of the eight psychology courses.

The set of courses should typically demonstrate a connection to the chosen interdepartmental major. You should think of these courses as plan of study. We realize the specific courses may change some. Should they change considerably, please review the changes with your advisor in the psychology department.
