## REGISTRATION

**Visiting and new students** who enroll in summer courses are designated as non-degree students. Visiting students from other colleges and universities should obtain permission from an appropriate official at their school if they wish to transfer credit from Union College. A copy of your college transcript is required.

**Qualified high school students** may enroll in any of the 100-level undergraduate courses. A high school recommendation and transcript are required.

**Union College Students:** In accordance with the summer school policy of the College, summer courses may be used to enhance your Union College education. They can be used to fulfill requirements for the major/minor or for the Core Curriculum Program and will appear on your transcript.

There will be a tuition charge for all course credits, including independent studies and internships.

**If you are currently behind in credits,** summer courses can be used towards the 36 minimum courses required for graduation.

**If you are NOT currently behind in credits,** summer courses will be an additional credit beyond the 36 required for Graduation and cannot be used to accelerate graduation.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### CREDIT SYSTEM

Union College is on a trimester system; course units rather than hours are applied. Unless otherwise noted, each course is equivalent to 3 1/3 semester hours or five-quarter hours.

Grades are awarded according to the following system:

A = 4.0	C+ = 2.3
A- = 3.7	C = 2.0
B+ = 3.3	C- = 1.7
B = 3.0	D = 1.0
B- = 2.7	F = 0.0

## INDEPENDENT STUDIES

Matriculated Union College students who intend to register for an independent study during the summer must submit their proposal to the faculty member who will supervise the student's study. Approval forms are available here: <https://www.union.edu/registrar/forms>

## TRANSCRIPTS

Union College has authorized the National Student Clearinghouse to provide transcript ordering via the Web. You can now order transcripts using any major credit card. Your card will only be charged after your order has been completed.

Current students can order transcripts online through our secure portal, [Webadvising](#) via the NSC Student Self-Service link using your student login and password.

Non-matriculated students can order transcripts via the web 24/7 through the National Student Clearinghouse at [www.studentclearinghouse.org](http://www.studentclearinghouse.org) and check on the link for Order-Track-Verify.

Transcripts **will not be released** if there are any outstanding holds on your account, financial or otherwise, including non-payment of any previous transcript requests.

## TUITION AND FEES

All non-Union college students will be billed the full amount of course tuition prior to the start of classes. Matriculated Union students will be billed after the summer term starts. **Late Registration fee of \$100** will be charged after the last day of registration, Monday, June 15th. (*Please note, June 8th for those considering PSY 210*).

## WITHDRAWALS

**To withdraw** from a course, a student must complete and submit the [Request to Withdraw Form](#) to the Registrar. Students who withdraw prior to the first class meeting **or** within seven calendar days of the first class meeting will receive tuition refund if they have paid in full. Students who withdraw between the second and the end of the fourth week of classes will be charged **full tuition** and the withdrawal will be recorded on the transcript as a "W". Withdrawal after the fourth week of class will be recorded as an "F" on the transcript. Any student who stops attending a course without submitting the Withdrawal Form will also receive an "F." ## VETERANS ADMINISTRATION

Veterans who are eligible to receive educational benefits under the various chapters administered by the V.A. may obtain more information by contacting the Registrar's Office. Entitlement will vary depending on the program. Veterans pay tuition and fees upon registering and subsequently receive benefit checks from the V.A. on a timely basis.
