DESCRIPTION OF COURSES NOT IN THE 2019-20 ACADEMIC REGISTER

Includes Revised Course Descriptions

AAH-117: An Introduction to the History of Architecture: Pyramids to Skyscrapers. Matthew, L. This course is a wide-ranging survey that will introduce students to the history of humankind's built environment within the Western tradition, with excursions to the Middle East. We will consider design, materials and techniques, patronage, function, and the evolution of the professions of builder and architect. We will also ask what buildings meant to the societies that built them, and how those meanings might have changed, and been manipulated, over time. No prerequisites.

ATH-105: Theatre Special Topics: Scene Painting. Mannion, A. Scenic Painting is an introduction to the processes, techniques, tools, and materials used in painting for film, theatre, and opera. Students study surface preparation, color theory and mixing, the manipulation of two-dimensional space through use of form and color, faux finishes and the interpretation of design elevations in the execution of completed scene painting. Three dimensional studies will include surface treatments, dimensional applications and foam carving. Students may also participate as scenic painters for the theatre department's production.

ATH-205: The Theatremaker's Toolkit. Wyatt, R. Study and practice in script analysis and interpretive modes, including Aristotelean, action-based, character, image and sensory, rhythm, plotline identification, fable distillation and others. These analytic tools are foundational for a variety of theatre practitioners: actors, directors, designers, technicians, playwrights and critics. Learn how to refine your approaches to a script to edge out others at auditions, create a foundation for stunning design or innovative direction.

ATH 310: Theatre for Community and Social Change. Wyatt, R. A multi-modal course examining the many forms of applied theatre with an emphasis on the work of Augusto Boal. Students will learn about educational and therapeutic modes of theatrical praxis, as well as learning techniques to build community and spark dialogue through performance. A portion of the class will be devoted to devising performance from a variety of non-script-based source materials. We will discuss and examine protest as performance, theatre for young adults, and theatrical practice for real-life situations.

BIO-108: Human Anatomy & Physiology I. Staff. The first course of a two-course sequence that introduces the structure and function of the human body, with an emphasis on providing a foundation for the study of pathological conditions. The processes by which the body maintains a stable internal environment (homeostasis) are stressed throughout. Topics include: an introduction to the human body; a review of general chemistry; an introduction to biological chemistry; cells; tissues; the integumentary system; the skeletal system; muscle tissue; joints and articulations; nerve tissue; the central nervous system; the peripheral nervous system; the autonomic nervous system; and special senses.

CLS-188: Ancient Astronomy, Winters, L. We will study the origins, history, theory, and practice of Ancient Greek and Roman astronomy, including influences from Egypt and Babylon, mythological and philosophical accounts of celestial phenomena, the classical geocentric model of the universe, and early observational and quantitative methods. Students will learn how ancient people measured time, made calendars, and organized their public world around the idea of an orderly and harmonious cosmos.

CLS-191: Ancient Engineering. Commito, A. How did people of the ancient Mediterranean physically transform the world around them, and what do those transformations tell us about their values and beliefs? This course introduces students to the major engineering successes (and failures!) of the communities living around the Mediterranean Sea and in southwest Asia. We explore well-known case studies – such as Egyptian pyramids, Assyrian siege engines, Persian *qanat* systems, Greek temples, and Roman aqueducts – as well as the humbler aspects of daily life, such as houses, sewers, and water clocks. We examine multiple forms of evidence, including archaeology, visual imagery, literature, inscriptions, ethnography, re-enactment, and modeling. Along the way, we reflect on how ancient developments in engineering have shaped our lives today.

CSC-033: Programming Practicum: Introduction to R. Striegnitz, K. introduction to the programming language R and how it can be used for statistical analysis and visualization of data. Students will learn how to write basic R

programs that can read, write, and manipulate data. They will make use of R functions for executing common statistical analysis and learn how to display the results using graphs and charts. Through a series of projects, students will get experience with writing their own functions, learn how to make use of R documentation and how to extend their own knowledge of the language. A student can receive a pass/fail credit equivalent to one elective course, if they receive a passing grade in this course as well as in two terms (normally in a row) of the CS practicum course (CSC 282 and 283).

CSC-084/EGL 284: Interactive Fiction Workshop. McAuliffe, S., Striegnitz, K. Interactive fiction is storytelling that uses technology to create an interactive “reading” experience, requiring the reader to make choices that influence the plot. In this course you are going to read, critique, and create interactive fiction. You’ll develop your storytelling skills, and along the way you’ll learn some programming concepts. The course is open to anyone who has taken a 100-level course in English. No previous CS experience is necessary. You need access to a laptop for class.

CSC-483/PHY-311: Special topics: Quantum Computing. Orzel, C. Anderson, M. This special topics course serves as an introduction to quantum computing and information. Students learn the basics of quantum computing starting from simple quantum systems, building up through linear algebra and quantum operators and circuits. Several quantum algorithms that exceed the known capabilities of classical computers are discussed, including Shor’s factoring algorithm. Physical realizations and limitations of quantum computing are also covered. This course assumes some background in either physics or computer science. Prerequisites: PHY 122 or CSC 151.

ECO-210: Economics of Information. Garcia, M. Information Economics studies how information affects the decision-making process and strategic behavior of individual economic units, such as firms and consumers. Information has economic value because it enables individuals to make better decisions that yield higher payoff than they would obtain from choices made in the absence of information. However, in many economic situations, individuals behave without full knowledge of the consequences of their actions, and often some individuals have better knowledge of the situation than others, arising the problem of asymmetric information. (Prerequisites : ECO 101)

ECO 213: Economics and Race in the US. Schmidt, S.J. This course considers the way that race affects economic outcomes in the United States. A person’s race has a great deal of influence on that person’s economic status, including his or her education, employment, housing, health care, standard of living, and general prospects for life. In this course we’ll see how economic forces, social and political forces, and history combine to generate the distribution of goods, services, wealth, and opportunity that we see in the United States. We’ll also ask how economic policy could be used to influence these distributions and make them fairer and more just. Common Curriculum: LCC. Interdisciplinary Programs: AMR, AFR. Prerequisites : ECO 101

ECO-373: Seminar in Environmental Economics. Abraham, C. This course will introduce several advanced topics in environmental economics. We shall consider the question: how do economists value goods that have no readily available monetary value, such as clean air or a biodiverse forest? We shall study tools used to answer this type of question, as well as ways of evaluating environmental programs and policies that are already put in place. I will start with an overview of the background material required to engage with the material in this course by covering some basic concepts in environmental economics. We shall spend time developing commonly used tools in environmental economics such as hedonic pricing methods, contingent valuation surveys, quasi-experimental program evaluation as well as an overview of cost-benefit analysis. I will do an overview of econometric techniques where appropriate. You will be required to develop a research topic using the tools discussed in class. The goal of this course is to teach techniques necessary to do analysis in environmental economics as well as familiarizing you with this literature. Prerequisite ECO 241 and 243

EXP-206: Big plans, Tiny houses - Plan and design a mobile science communication cottage. Theodosiou, N. Ever wonder how businesses get started? What makes a good idea successful? In this experiential course, students explore the *foundation* and *inspiration* phases of planning a mobile tiny house that will travel to local communities in Schenectady, the Adirondacks and Mohawk Valley to communicate science and the arts. In the first half of the course, students will investigate current mobile science labs and similar mobile community outreach vehicles; what they offer, how they are managed, funded, and supported. Students will network with local schools and community centers to

identify market needs, and with alumni who have expertise in community theater, set design, fundraising, marketing, and outreach. Students will work in teams to develop ideas that will inform 1) construction design; 2) content design; 3) business plan; and 4) marketing. Participants in this course will be given priority enrollment in follow-up courses that include a science communication interdisciplinary course, and a Design + Build miniterm, in which we will physically build a tiny house! First year students are encouraged to enroll and will be matched with upperclassmen peer mentors. No prerequisites. Petition required.

EXP-246: Educational Psychology Internship. Fredrick, J. STUDENTS WILL PARTICIPATE IN EITHER A VIRTUAL OR IN PERSON INTERNSHIP FOR APPROXIMATELY 10-12 HOURS PER WEEK AT A KIPP NYC MIDDLE OR HIGH SCHOOL. Students will tutor and mentor middle and high school students, help with college preparatory activities, and potentially lead groups of students in social and emotional learning and enrichment activities. Students will connect their hands-on experiences with developmental and educational psychology readings, reflective writing assignments, and weekly class discussions. Dean Jenny Fredricks will teach the course; contact her for more information at fredricj@union.edu. *This course can serve as a psychology elective*

HST-217: Slavery & the American South. Staff. An in-depth examination of the rise of American slavery and the evolution of the American South, from variations of unfree labor in the colonial period to the terrors of the "Cotton Kingdom" in the antebellum era to the rise of "Second Slavery" after the Civil War. Particular attention will be paid to emerging concepts of race, the connections between white freedom and black bondage, and popular myths about slavery and American history.

MER-292A: Research/Entrepreneurship Practica 1. Andersen, A. This is the first term of a two-term practicum designed to supplement undergraduate research experiences through exposure to introductory entrepreneurial practice using techniques and resources similar to those employed in the National Science Foundation's Innovation Corps (NSF I-Corps) program. Before enrolling in the practicum, students must have research experience through participation in either summer research, scholar's project, or research practicum. In the first term (MER/CHM 292a) students will continue their disciplinary research with an eye towards selecting an application area to pursue while learning initial NSF I-Corps based methods and techniques. Students will prepare a presentation on the intended product or application area, assemble a team to develop it, and prepare an initial business model canvas. Expectations include a minimum of four hours per week working on their research and learning the I-Corps based methods plus attendance at research/practicum meetings. A student who receives three terms of passing grades (MER/CHM 291, 292a and 293a) receives Pass/Fail credit equivalent to one course. Prereq: MER291/CHM291 and permission of instructor.

MIN-200: Environment and Society. Bisdoshi, K. The impact of human actions on the environment is indisputable. Indeed, the change in the environment itself is a direct result of human action; through our actions we destroy habitats and endanger our very own future. In this course we examine environmental problems in Russia and the United States and consider what one can do today to answer for tomorrow. We take an interdisciplinary approach to one of our greatest challenges, our world's environmental crisis. Topics we will cover include: waste production, water pollution, air pollution, deforestation, natural resource use (and abuse) and environmental disasters. We tackle these problems from an interdisciplinary point of view with lectures by faculty experts in the fields of Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Engineering, Geology and History and community members who work for an NGO, a national park and in industries. This course fulfills major requirements in the following programs: Environmental, Science and Policy, History and Russian and East European Studies; it also carries the following Common Curriculum credits: Language and Culture (LCC) and Humanities (HUM).

MIN-207 / MLT217: Challenging Times: A Call for Global Citizenship and Creative Engagement . Bisdoshi, K, Henseler, C. Nelson-Mukherjee, E., Ndiaye, C., Ueno J. Polls have found that over 50% of individuals across 14 countries see themselves more as global citizens than as citizens of their own country. Young people today are especially connected to people and cultures from around the world given their ability to travel, to communicate and to access information. They also understand that to address today's challenges, including our world's environmental crisis, our refugee and human rights crisis, or our world's poverty crisis, we must become engaged and creative global thinkers and forces for change. What do we need to learn and understand about cultural differences and cultural change

to become more competent, collaborative and respectful in our lives and careers? And how can we contribute meaningfully to our local and global communities? What is our place in the world? In this introductory class, students will actively engage with what it means to be a global citizen. This foundation will be enhanced through real-life case studies from around the world that will allow students to see themselves as part of a shared community. This course will include speakers, intercultural communication, mini language workshops, and digital storytelling projects that will enhance students' critical reflection on purposeful global citizenship.

MIN-208: Like ordinary people, nations can be complicated: they have good things and they have bad things. The United States is of course not exempt from this complexity. Zaibert, L. This course is about one bad thing about the United States: its depressingly unjust system of criminal justice. Amongst the many reasons why the system is unfair we will discuss, its reliance on an increasingly unmanageable and inhumane carceral system, its anachronistic endorsement of the death penalty, and its metastatic growth in terms of what it criminalizes and what it punishes. If this were not bad enough, we will study the many connections between these grave ills and the United States' fraught history of racism. Sadly, there is a clear line that goes from slavery via convict lease programs and Jim Crow laws, to the mess we have today. Focusing on this particularly bad thing about the United States is not motivated by masochism or by a desire to unduly trash the country. It is, rather, an effort to contribute to the country's progress. Even though, mainly as a result of the widespread availability of cameras (in our phones, etc.) witnessing harrowing atrocity after harrowing atrocity has become routine, these events are just the tip of the iceberg. Many of us remain either insufficiently aware or fully unaware of the dysfunctionality of the American criminal justice system or of its systematic connection to racism. It is naïve to expect progress regarding any of these problems if we are not at least aware of them, and if we do not manage to understand what they really are and why they came to be.

PSY-216: Social Determinants of Health. Esiaka, D. This course explores how the social environment and social behavior(s) influence health and disability, and how social factors contribute to health inequities and inequalities in general and across the life course. It is not constrained to a single discipline, but represents a confluence of interdisciplinary research streams covering the diverse fields of psychology, gerontology, public health, nursing, social demography, medical sociology, public policy, and health economics.

PSY-262: Body Project Peer Leadership. Walker, D. Mental Health is most certainly a Global Challenge. Among adolescents and young adults, in particular, body image dissatisfaction and eating disorders are both common and associated with significant impairment, distress, and negative health outcomes. Students in this remotely-delivered experiential learning course will be trained on how to deliver the Body Project as peer leaders. The Body Project is an evidence based program that improves body satisfaction and prevents eating disorders by helping participants combat unhealthy appearance ideals. Students will be trained as peer leaders, will create promotional materials for current and future Body Project workshops, will organize and run at least one remote workshop, will be assigned some readings/videos, and will complete reflection assignments on the process.

PSC-276R: Housing Policy. Wiest, S. Housing is an essential human need. Housing is also a critical part of the U.S. economy and many household's economic wealth (or lack thereof) is reflective of their position in the housing market. This course will explore a range of issues relating to U.S. housing policy, including the role housing plays in building and strengthening neighborhoods and communities. Students will study the structure of housing and related financial markets and the economic and social bases for governments to intervene in these markets. Additional topics include a systematic review of major federal housing programs for homeownership and rental housing production, a section focusing on public housing and rental vouchers, and an exploration of the larger economic and political context of housing today including demographic and market issues. The last section of the course examines the social and spatial segmentation of housing in the U.S. Of particular interest, is the fact of racial discrimination in housing which has produced a deeply segregated residential structure. PSC 111 or PSC 112 or Sophomore standing

PSC-335: Antigone and Feminist Refusal. Marso, L. This course examines feminist forms of refusals including dissent, strike, interruption, disruption, waywardness, protest, and assembly as they are depicted in ancient texts, and that reappear in contemporary literature, film, and television. Primary figures include Antigone (Sophocles), Cassandra (Homer's *Illiad*, Aeschylus *Agamemnon*, and Euripides, *Trojan Women*), Medea (Euripides), the women of *The*

Bacchae (Euripides) and *Lysistrata* (Aristophanes). After studying each classical text we jump forward to ask how classical female figures are continually reinvented and reinserted into new narratives and new histories with vastly varying implications.

PSC 345: POLITICS OF PRIVATE PROPERTY. Siegel, D. Private property is often treated as a natural and universal social institution that resides somewhere outside the political realm. Yet, few other social institutions play as large a role in determining “who gets what, when, and how,” to quote Laswell’s famous definition of politics. This course is designed to interrogate the often hidden—though sometimes overt—politics of private property. In addition to studying political struggles based on access to or exclusion from the world’s resources and commodities—all mediated by property—we will carefully note the radical diversity of private property forms that have existed historically, as well as their variations today. Indeed, private property is not one thing. The pervasive expansion of the economic realm into the social and political world has entailed a dramatic extension of property rights. Today, the type of objects that can be privatized, to be bought and sold as commodities, is almost limitless and includes ideas, personal data, and even genetic material. The thematic topics of the course will take us through a comparative-historical analysis of the origins of capitalism in Europe, colonial and post-colonial capitalism, the politics of Soviet collectivization and subsequent privatization, and, finally, the international politics of inequality and dispossession linked to contemporary neoliberal globalization. Prerequisites: PSC 111 or 112 or SO Standing

PSC-399: Revolutions & the International Order. Ahmed, S. Revolution is one of the most controversial topics both within and without the area of international politics. Despite the vast differences among theories of international relations, what is undeniable is that the contemporary world of politics would be inconceivable without taking into account revolutions such as the 1765-1783 American revolution, 1789 French revolution, 1791-1804 Haitian revolution, 1848 revolutions in Europe, 1917 October revolution, 1949 Chinese revolution, and various anti-colonial revolutions throughout most of the 20th century. This course combines analytic, critical, and historical lines of inquiry. Therefore, we will study texts by political thinkers, critical theorists, and historians while at the same time discuss ongoing events and reflect on selected commentaries, literary works, and works of art. PSC 111 or PSC 112 or PSC 113 or Sophomore standing

REL-160: Introduction to Buddhism: Visions of Awakening. Verchery, L. This introductory course explores Buddhist understandings of the human condition and visions of human flourishing. We cover the major histories, doctrines and practices of Buddhism, from the fifth century BCE to the present day, by engaging sacred texts from the Buddhist canon as well as poetry, literature, autobiography and film. We consider how Buddhism has changed and evolved as it spread from India, to Central and East Asia and, more recently, to the West. Key themes include the question of suffering, the nature of compassion, training the emotions, and the place of the ordinary and imperfect within Buddhist visions of enlightenment. Throughout the course, we consider the relevance of class material to our own views and experiences of the world, and to the question of how we should live our lives.

REL-284: Religion and Film. Verchery, L. In this introductory course, we explore how the language of cinema can help us expand our understanding of religion. In addition to watching films *about* religious topics, we will also use religion as a lens to interpret a variety of films in multiple genres — documentary, experimental, horror, comedy, ethnographic — asking in each case how the cinematic medium illuminates existential questions of “ultimate concern”. In addition to using film to critically expand our understandings of “religion,” we will also learn the foundations of filmic language and cinematic analysis. Instead of a final exam, students may elect to either write a final paper or create an original video-essay.

SPN-424: Imaginarios urbanos: Interventions in the Latin American City. Yi, S. The rapid rate of urbanization in Latin America makes the continent one of the most urbanized in the world. As such, studying the city as a center of cultural, political, social, and economic power is, more than ever, crucial to understanding life in the present. This course explores Latin American cities as sites where artists engage with public space in order to both call attention to injustices and experiment with practices of modifying urban life. These interventions respond to the conditions that shape each city to reveal the power relations at work. Students will examine and analyze efforts to reimagine a more

democratic city as presented in short stories, stencil, graffiti, installations, *escraches*, photography, street theater, and teatro de la invasión. Prerequisite(s): Two 300-level courses. CC: HUL, HUM, LCCS, WAC.
