DESCRIPTION OF COURSES NOT IN THE 2020-21 ACADEMIC REGISTER

Includes Revised Course Descriptions

ANT-205: Men and Masculinity. Khan, A. This class examines the construction of gender through the study of men and masculinity. The primary focus of gender studies has been on women and femininity specifically, but in recent decades scholars have come to recognize that gender is a relational concept and cannot be understood without understanding the role of men and the construction of masculinity. In this class, we examine how male roles are defined across societies and how men must live up to and abide by different ideals of masculinity. Understanding this gives us insight into crucial social issues related to the family, religion, politics and economy. LCC, GSWS.

AMU-240: Recording, Mixing, and Synthesizing Sound. Chandler, C. This course is a continuation of the concepts introduced in AMU 140. It is designed to give you a set of skills needed to record, mix, and master musical projects using microphones, pre-amps, analog and digital mixers, synthesizers, and digital audio workstations. The content of this course focuses on the hardware and software tools, techniques, and practices necessary to produce polished pieces of music. Through both technical and creative projects, we will dive deeper into concepts from acoustics and psychoacoustics, microphone placement and selection, audio routing, sound processing, and synthesizer programming. Prerequisites: AMU 140 or permission of the instructor.

BIO-109-01: Human Anatomy and Physiology II. Eggen, B. The second term of a two-term sequence that introduces the structure and function of the human body, with an emphasis on providing a foundation for the study of pathological conditions. The processes by which the body maintains a stable internal environment (homeostasis) are stressed throughout. Topics include the following body systems: endocrine, cardiovascular (blood, heart, vessels), lymphatic, immune, respiratory, digestive (and metabolism), urinary (and fluid/electrolyte balance), and reproductive. This course does not count toward the Biology major or any affiliated major. It is strictly an elective toward graduation. Students with a documented interest in allied health professions will be given preference to register for this class. Prerequisite: HA&P I (Bio-108) and lab. Prerequisites: BIO108 Human Anatomy & Physiology I or equivalent.

CLS-147: Women in Ancient Rome. Raucci, S. This course will address the lives of women in ancient Rome. We will examine the themes of labor, dress, family, religion, law, and medicine, among others, in a variety of sources (literary, epigraphic, visual). We will examine not only the lived realities of Roman women, but how they were perceived and represented in ancient society. HUM

CLS-155: History of the Book. Winter L. We will learn about the technological, material, and cultural history of the preservation of written language, from the earliest scripts in stone to contemporary digital publishing. Although the focus will rest mostly on the development of the western codex-style book from early papyrus rolls to the invention of the printing press, we will explore other forms of writing preservation from many cultures. Students will learn the histories of various scripts (including the development of the alphabet), writing technologies, and book manufacturing practices. As an overarching theme, we will discuss how changes in book production inspired cultural changes, and vice versa. HUM

CLS-202 Introduction to Archaeological Methods. Commito, A. Believe it or not, there is more to archaeology than raiding tombs or cracking a bullwhip. What can we learn about people in the past through physical remains? What else do archaeologists do besides dig in the dirt? Students address these and other questions by conducting original research through a series of hands-on experiences both in and outside the classroom, including architectural drawing, spatial analysis, archival research with historical documents, isotopic analysis, demographic fieldwork in a local cemetery, 3D modeling, and museum exhibition design. Students work in teams, lead class discussions, present original research, and use their new skills in interpreting material culture to analyze the world around them in new and surprising ways. HUM

ECO-210: Economics of Information. Garrido, D. Information Economics studies how information affects the decision-making process and strategic behavior of individual economic units, such as firms and consumers. Information has economic value because it enables individuals to make better decisions that yield higher payoff than they would obtain from choices made in the absence of information. However, in many economic situations, individuals behave

without full knowledge of the consequences of their actions, and often some individuals have better knowledge of the situation than others, arising the problem of asymmetric information. This course will cover concepts, models, and tools to analyze how economic agents make decisions under scenarios of information asymmetry, with applications to pricing strategies, insurance markets, consumer behavior and marketing strategies, environmental economics, and digital information and the economics of the Internet. (Prerequisites: ECO-101).

ECO-239: Economics of Development. Giri, J. The issues in development economics deal with the causes that limit the ability of a nation or an individual to have proper education, health, employment, income and a desired standard of living. The causes may be economic, social, political and institutional in nature. In this course, we will explore these causes and find possible policies that can be implemented to address the problems. Each topic will be supplemented by a case study of a country from either Africa, South Asia, or Latin America. Additionally, we will use statistical data and graphs to make comparative analysis between countries.

ECO-312: Seminar in Economic and Financial Forecasting. Karadas, E. The increasing complexity and the uncertainty of global markets is fueling the demand for professional experts who possess a good understanding of statistical tools to solve forecasting problems and the necessary computer skills to create relevant forecasts. Therefore, a proper understanding and training in time series analysis and forecasting is a highly valuable asset. This economic and financial forecasting class combines the essential tools in economics, statistics, and programming to meet these growing needs. In particular, students will be taught the formal procedures of identifying and understanding characteristics of time series and financial data, and the skills for developing and analyzing models for forecasting time series data. Furthermore, we will discuss "real-world" applications for modeling and evaluating forecasts upon which decision-making would depend. Substantial emphasis will also be placed on the efficient and effective use of the R programming language. All assignments will require extensive use of R. Prerequisites: ECO 101, ECO 243. WAC

EGL-245-01: Experimental Texts. Mitchell, J. Experiments in writing have a long history and are often some combination of fascinating, weird, complex, risky, and wild. This course will cross genre-boundaries in order to discover what it means to read, write, and experience "experimental" literature, which usually attempts to challenge the traditions, formal devices, and audience expectations of literary engagement. With a focus on the relationship between form and content as well as attention paid to the limitations associated with strict categorical delineations of literary and cultural objects, we will spend the term analyzing and producing experimental texts. We will spend time considering primarily contemporary textual responses to cultural, social, and political shifts and the ways in which such shifts inform and affect our reading practices. Readings will include poetry, fiction, theory, and contemporary media. Writing assignments will include interpretive and creative works. Collaborative projects will also be a part of this course. Pre-requisites: one 100-level EGL class or permission of the instructor. HUL, HUM, WAC.

ECO-320-01: Political Economy of Development in Asia Dang, H. Have you ever been fascinated by the phenomenal growth rates of Asian countries such as Singapore, Japan and South Korea in the last few decades? Would you like to find out the underlying mechanisms of their success stories? How could less developed countries use the lessons from these cases to catch up with the rest of the world? What are the major development challenges that are particular to Asia and how to overcome them? This course will help you approach the answers to these questions by first equipping you with the theoretical framework and econometric tools that guide your exploration and evaluation of relevant scholarly research. Then, we will examine the development experience of Asia through various case studies with a focus on their political economy aspects. The course will culminate in a major individual research project that you will undertake for a substantial portion of your final grade. (Prerequisites : ECO 241, ECO 242, ECO 243)
Common Curriculum: WAC. Interdisciplinary Programs: AS

CSC-033-01: Programming Practicum: Introduction to R. Striegnitz, K. An introduction to the programming language R and how it can be used for statistical analysis and visualization of data. Students will learn how to write basic R programs that can read, write, and manipulate data. They will make use of R functions for executing common statistical analysis and learn how to display the results using graphs and charts. Through a series of projects, students will get experience with writing their own functions, learn how to make use of R documentation and how to extend their own knowledge of the language. A student can receive a pass/fail credit equivalent to one elective course, if they receive a passing grade in this course as well as in two terms (normally in a row) of the CS practicum course (CSC 282 and 283).

FLM-220: The Science Fiction Film: Space and Speculative Constructions of the Future. de Seve, J.

Space, the final frontier! Generations of filmmakers have created stunning visions of the future. Join this course's exciting ride across the film work of legends like Méliès, Tarkovsky, Kubrick and others as we collectively explore the role of film in imagining tomorrow. How did these films influence technology? What promise did science fiction offer for social justice and world harmony? How do we place the fluid genre of science fiction across changing social and political landscapes? Critical media analysis skills practiced in this course will translate over many other disciplines. Work includes film viewing and reading as well as filming and writing exercises. The Science Fiction Film counts toward a Film Studies minor. Prerequisites: None. HUM

FLM-315: Master Filmmakers: An Exploration of Cinematic Style. de Seve, J. Working from film analysis writings and video essays about film, Master Filmmakers helps students understand the range of styles and influence of some of the world's most revered filmmakers. From Jane Campion to Akira Kurosawa to Michael Bay, students will partake in their own film analyses to assemble the building blocks of film style. Critical media analysis skills practiced in this course will translate over many other disciplines. Work includes film viewing and reading as well as filming and writing exercises. Master Filmmakers counts toward a Film Studies minor. Prerequisites: None. HUM

FRN-316-01 Environmental Imaginations in the Francophone World. Bouhet, E. This course engages with 20th and 21st Century literature, visual arts and essays by French and Francophone authors from different continents, often directly affected by environmental crisis. In this class, you will become familiar with key theoretical concepts of ecocritical and postcolonial theory by discovering canonic as well as marginalized works. During the term, you will reflect on how reading fiction and theory as well as writing on the environment can contribute to the collective effort humans must make to address the urgency of climate change. The course will culminate with a creative research project you will share with your peers. Course conducted in French. Pre-requisite: FRN-201 or a 300-level French course. LCC, HUM, HUL.

GEO-160 – Living with the Mohawk: exploring the intersection of surface waters and society. Garver, J. The Mohawk Watershed is an introductory course that investigates the complex intersection of surface water hydrology and society. The focus is on water quality, dams, the Erie Canal, invasive species, floods, and river-proximal development. Course modules investigate the relationship between aging infrastructure, water quality, and climate change. Specific projects and topics include the urban stream syndrome, dams and dam removal, invasive species and the Erie Canal, and flood mitigation solutions in the Stockade. Prerequisite(s): none. SCLB. WAC

GSW-101-01: LGBTQ+ Studies. Mitchell, J. This course is a transdisciplinary introduction to lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer (LGBTQ+) studies. We will explore histories of sexualities; forms of systemic and structural oppression including heterosexism, homophobia, and transphobia and resistance to them; violence against LGBTQ+ people; intersectional queer activism throughout history; diverse experiences of sexuality, desire, and identity; and representations of LGBTQ+ people and experiences in literature, art, and popular culture. Our approach to class material will be intersectional, focusing on the connection between multiple identity components including, but not limited to, race, gender, class, and sexuality. HUL, HUM.

HEB-101: Basic Hebrew 2. Zilberberg, K. The Hebrew language program at Union College is a year-long sequence of three courses designed to cover the basic skills in reading, writing, and conversing in Hebrew. Continuation of A HEB 100. This course is designed to achieve a basic proficiency in Modern Hebrew. Students learn to read and communicate in different contexts. This interactive course will introduce you to the fundamentals of modern spoken and written Hebrew. Learn the 4 skills of language: reading different genres, writing, listening, and speaking in Hebrew. The program is interactive and uses a variety of methods for teaching and learning. **Prerequisite: A Hebrew 100 or students who know the Hebrew letters and vowels.**

HST 370: Indigenous Rights in Latin America. McGrath, E. Where did the vibrant indigenous rights movements that are changing the face of Latin America come from? In this course, we will trace the long history of indigenous communities demanding rights from the state and from international organizations over the course of the 19th and 20th centuries. What are indigenous rights? What is a settler state? In order to answer these questions, this course asks you to think about history differently: can we imagine history as something other than a line of progress? Can political struggles be the same if the language that describes them changes? This class will explore alternative conceptions of

history, agency, and change as we answer these questions. We will focus on indigenous communities in Bolivia and Guatemala primarily, with a chance for students to pursue a research topic of their choice. Prerequisite: petition. LCC, LACS, WAC

ISC-220: Global Engagement. Osborn, M. This course is intended to actively engage students who are interested in tackling global challenges through critical inquiry, intercultural exchange, and community engagement. Through examining concepts and critiques within international development, humanitarian aid, and social enterprise, this course will require students to question what it means “to help” and how to do so in culturally appropriate ways. Students will examine both theoretical and practical approaches in working with nonprofit and social entrepreneurship organizations and embark upon a focused research project that will allow them to explore these challenges in-depth. The course will include former Minerva Fellows, guest speakers, as well as local scholars and experts who will aim to deepen students' understanding of community engagement both in the US and abroad.

MIN-206 Challenge Yourself & Others: Can You Live A More Sustainable Life?. Henseler, C. If you want to be part of the solution, be part of this class. Pledge to change your habits and develop and implement a project of your choice to shift the behavior of others. In this class you will read articles, watch TEDtalks and documentaries, and examine the impact of your actions around what you eat, wear, and consume, how you live, travel, and even think about your future careers. You will research impact studies, explore companies and innovators that do good, interview friends and family, invite speakers, and design a sustainability project of your choice. In this class you will increase your own awareness of how to live a more sustainable life and you will take action and have direct impact on our world. ESPE, HUM, WAC

MIN-211 Conspiracy Theories and Their Defenders. Stablein, T. In recent years, conspiracy theories have entered into popular discourse and pervaded American politics, exploiting particularly vulnerable groups and threatening the integrity of our democracy. In this course we will explore why people believe in conspiracy theories and misinformation, the actors involved, and motivations for perpetuating these beliefs in the absence of evidence. Conspiracy theories attempt to explain a wide variety of events and actions that have occurred throughout our history which call into question generally accepted narratives and explanations (such as the moon landing, the JFK assassination, and the 9/11 terrorist attacks). Conspiracy theories also attempt to create and explain the presence of fictitious, clandestine entities and affairs such as the existence of a “deep state” or a “new world order” or the actions and motivations of these groups and their involvement in nefarious affairs (e.g. QAnon). Each week, students will evaluate selected conspiracy theories and research which attempt to explain the psychology and sociology of conspiracy theory belief, as well as explanations offered by political scientists, economists, and historians. Each class, students will evaluate specific conspiracy theories and their proponents. Students will also explore these topics on their own through independent research projects in an effort to disentangle fact from fiction and the rationale for their adoption. SOCS

MTH-334-01: Partial Differential Equation. Partial differential equations (PDEs) are formulated to describe a wide range of phenomena in engineering, natural and social sciences. We will study the theories and models of PDEs. Analytical and numerical methods are introduced to examine the solutions of elliptic, parabolic, and hyperbolic types of PDEs. Topics include the formulation of PDEs using conservation laws, classification, solution methods for the wave, diffusion, and Laplace equations, boundary value problems, separation of variables, Green's functions, Fourier series and transforms, stability and convergence. Students will be exposed to both theoretical and applied aspects. Computing tools (such as Mathematica or Matlab) will also be introduced. Prerequisites: MTH 234 or {MTH 130 + MTH 199}.

PSY-238-01: Power and Group Dynamics. O'Dea, C. Society is structured in hierarchies. These hierarchies are created on several different factors: merit, race, gender, sexual orientation, religion, etc. While the legitimacy of these hierarchies is heavily debated in public discourse, on social media, and in other platforms, there is little consensus about the merits/issues/disadvantages of social hierarchy. In a general sense, people who value social hierarchies impress the viewpoint that groups and individuals at the top earned their way to the top via hard work and merit while groups and individuals at the bottom are there because they did not do the right things or make the right choices. In this

course, students will research power and group dynamics to better understand ways that different social groups have gained, lost, or fight to reinforce their position in the status hierarchy. Prerequisites: PSY 100

PSY-260-01: Culture and Psychology. Esiaka, D. This course will give students an understanding of the variety of human behavior as it emerges in the cultural context, of the development of individual characteristics in relation to cultural factors, and of what happens to individuals as their cultural system undergoes significant change. Throughout the term, we will explore, examine, and better understand how culture influences our lives and the lives of others across the world. Prerequisites: PSY 100

PSC-398: The Body and Borders, Ahmed,S. In this course we will deconstruct and problematize, analyze and re-conceptualize, de-normalize and theorize, the mechanisms of state politics in relation to both the body and territorialization. In addition to learning about the nature and mechanisms of biopolitics, we will study some essential aspects of the international relations of biopower. The topics include discipline, control, borders, governmentality, forms and methods of political oppression, refugees, and “bare life.” The readings include works by Hannah Arendt, Michel Foucault, Reece Jones, Giorgio Agamben, Étienne Balibar, Slavoj Žižek, Alain Badiou, Danna Haraway, Michael Hardt, Antonio Negri, Roberto Esposito, and Gilles Deleuze. Prerequisites: Familiarity with international politics, political theory, or history of ideas

REL 260-01 Zen Buddhism and Meditation. Verchery, L. This course is an overview of the advent and development of Zen (Chinese: Chan 禪), a form of Buddhism centered on the practice of meditation. Using both primary and secondary sources, we cover the premodern origins of Buddhist meditation in India, the institutionalization of Chan in China, and its subsequent transnational journey throughout Japan, East Asia and the world. We consider the influence of Zen on the modern mindfulness movement and on widespread secular interest in meditation and wellness. Major subthemes include the question of religious experience; history and genealogy; Zen theories of language; Zen modernism and its influence in psychology, neuroscience and medicine. Throughout the course, we highlight the continual processes of translation, change and adaptation that have characterized Zen Buddhism since its beginning. LCC, HUM

SOC-226 Medical Social Work. Patterson, R. An overview of the social work role in health care settings as an advocate, practitioner, and leader within interdisciplinary teams. A comprehensive view of the professional values, theories, and methods that social workers utilize in this role to provide advocacy, individual, family and group counseling, educate patients and families, effective crisis intervention, resource referrals and influence public health policies. (Prerequisites SOC 100)

SPN 334 Cartographies of Disaster in the Latin American Context. Yi, S. The association between Latin America and catastrophe paints a unidimensional picture that does not correlate with the region's political, social, and geographical reality. With its history of colonialism, natural disasters, civil wars, dictatorships, and economic and political crises, Latin America is repeatedly constructed on the myth of disaster--whether natural or man-made. Disaster, by definition, is a serious disruption that causes great damage and involves human, material, economic and/or environmental loss. As such, it oftentimes leaves no room for discussion even if what constitutes a disaster can be subjective. In this class, we will tease out the problematic association between disaster and Latin America by exploring the effects of a disaster beyond the physical. Through concrete examples and its cultural representations, we will study the ways in which disaster is defined and experienced while analyzing its implications, political and otherwise. By drawing connections between disasters, their representations, and their relationship to politics and history, we will discuss issues including identity, class, power, extraction, and accessibility

SPN-382-01: Between Power and Justice: Noir Narratives in Spain and Latin America. Collinge,D. This course examines crime narratives in the Spanish-speaking world (including Argentina, Chile, Colombia, México, Paraguay, and Spain) from the last 100 years. In addition to gaining familiarity with *el género negro* (the noir genre, in novels, short stories, poetry, and films), students will use critical theory to investigate relationships between violence, power, social class, and politics. Students should be prepared for extensive reading, weekly writing assignments, and lively in-class discussion. Prerequisites: SPN 203 or permission of the instructor. LCC, HUL, HUM, LACS, WAC
