## DESCRIPTION OF COURSES NOT IN THE 2020-21 ACADEMIC REGISTER

**\*Includes Revised Course Descriptions\***

**ANT 211: The Anthropology of Intimacy.** Leavitt, S. Sex, love and marriage are all expressions of human intimacy, yet practices vary widely across societies. This course looks at universal needs for intimacy in cultural context. It begins with how men and women are defined culturally. Then it considers a range of sexual activities as societal demands or expressions of love. How does a given society define romantic love? How is homosexuality regarded? How does love magic work? Intimacy is steered through culturally defined roles, from sex workers to men playing the roles of women. Sexual antagonism sees men and women as dangerous to each other; how does love and marriage work in such societies? Marriage practices, from arranged marriage to marriage based on love, from polygamy to monogamy, all arise based on cultural demands as well. The course includes a look at the emotional legacy of sexual assault on college campuses. Pre-requisites: None. GenEd: LCC, SOSC

**ECO 213: Economics and Race in the US.** Schmidt, SJ. This course considers the way that race affects economic outcomes in the United States. A person's race has a great deal of influence on that person's economic status, including his or her education, employment, housing, health care, standard of living, and general prospects for life. In this course, we'll see how economic forces, social and political forces, and history combine to generate the distribution of goods, services, wealth, and opportunity that we see in the United States. We'll also ask how economic policy could be used to influence these distributions and make them fairer and more just. **Common Curriculum:** LCC. **Interdisciplinary Programs:** AMS, AFR. **Prerequisites:** ECO 101

**EGL 102: Introduction to Literary Studies: Drama.** Wareh, P. In this course, we will ask how different representations of disguise help to articulate the themes with which drama is so concerned. Not only do plays acted on the stage abound in examples of characters switching places or mistaken for each other, they also provide a forum for individual characters to question their relationship with the people and culture that surround them. Even as plays stage the most private of feelings in a public setting, they also suggest that human interactions frequently involve playing a role. Throughout our examination of mix-ups, imposters, and identity crises in plays that range from ancient times to the present day, we will pay attention to both the literary and theatrical conventions of drama and the changing social place of the theater. HUL, WAC.

**EGL 201-01 / ATH 257: Shakespeare after 1600.** Venning, D. In this course we will explore plays written in the second half of Shakespeare's career. We will emphasize Shakespeare's great tragedies—works that retain their ability to astound readers and audiences today—but we'll also explore his later comedies, "problem plays," and tragicomic final works. We will collaborate to appreciate the sounds and meaning of Shakespeare's language, to think about the ways he structures plots and creates vivid characters, to understand the cultural milieu in which his plays were written, to make thematic connections across the plays, and to appreciate the plays as both literature and in performance. Shakespearean drama can be challenging to study, but the rewards are lifelong: revelry in language, a strong grounding in theatrical traditions that remain dominant in our culture, a deeper understanding of the actions and values that motivate human beings in society, and an engagement with dramatic works that continue to be reimagined worldwide. **Prerequisite(s):** EGL 100, 101, or 102 or a grade of 5 on the AP English Literature or Language test. **CC:** HUL, HUM, WAC

**EGL 251: World Literatures in English.** Pease, A. Besides the USA, Canada, the UK and Ireland, there are dozens of countries where English is commonly spoken and written. From Australia to Zimbabwe, Belize to Nigeria, Jamaica to India, New Zealand to Kenya, literature in English is a world-wide phenomenon. In this course, students will read and analyze English-language poems, short stories, personal essays, and novels from a selection of far-flung countries, to learn about the peoples' cultures, histories, struggles, and achievements. Pre-requisites: EGL 100 or 101 or 102. LCC, HUL, WAC.

**EGL 262: Global Modernisms.** Mitchell, J. This course examines global fiction from the early twentieth century, a period often referred to as the "modernist" era. Modernist writers were literary and cultural pioneers, experimenting

with prose and poetry in ways that challenged and unsettled readers; yet such changes have come to be seen as important innovations in literary style. In addition to engaging with questions of form and style, writers from this period were also interested in subjects that were previously viewed as taboo, questionable, and, as such, often unspeakable. These topics included, but are not limited to, trauma, war, sexuality, insanity, and newly carved out gender and familial roles. Perhaps most importantly for our class, modernist writers created spaces for themselves and their work all over the world. From writers in exile to writers living under colonial/imperial rule, the relationship between modernism and culture is inherently dialogic. We will interrogate the relationship between modernist experimentation, nation, and identity, focusing on writers from America, the United Kingdom, the Caribbean, Asia, and Europe. Throughout our term together, we will critically consider, discuss, and write about the dynamic between the content of modernist writing, its innovative style and form, and its connection to place and space. Pre-requisites: one 100-level EGL class or permission of the instructor. HUL, HUM, WAC.

**EGL 304: Junior Seminar: *The Faerie Queene*. Wareh, P.** This course will explore Edmund Spenser's wild and wacky epic poem, *The Faerie Queene*. Published in 1596, *The Faerie Queene* is full of powerful women, knights, dragons, monsters, and more; its rich cast includes both Queen Elizabeth I and a young King Arthur. In depicting a world full of chivalry and adventure, this poem offers striking insights into how Shakespeare's contemporaries understood their society and themselves. Full of beautiful lyrics, comedy, and tragedy, *The Faerie Queene* shows the many different possibilities for thinking about how Renaissance readers viewed the relationship between poetry and social identity. This poem is thus a fascinating window into Renaissance society even as it explores issues still relevant today, from questions about female agency to religious prejudice to class and social conflict. Students will be offered guidance in developing their own projects to explore *The Faerie Queene*, and the focus of the class discussions will be determined by student interests. Counts as pre-1700 credit for English majors and minors. HUL, WAC.

**FRN 317: France After #Me Too. Bouhet, E.** This course engages with the aftermath of the global #Me Too movement in France. Can we say that the #Balancetonporc movement is the French equivalent of the #Me Too movement? In this class, students will read literary pieces that emerged from the #Me Too era as well as press articles that address issues related to sexual assault, sexual harassment, incest and feminicides. Such readings will make us consider the political impact of the movement. Only in the spring of 2021 has France passed a law establishing the age of consent at 15. Before that, age was not a valid category in regards to consent. From publications to protests, to new laws, one thing is certain, #Me Too has shaken up France. Course conducted in French. Prerequisite: FRN-201 or a 300-level French course. LCC, HUM, HUL, WAC, GSWS.

**HST-254: European Environmental History: Luneau, T.** This course examines the evolving relationship between humans and the natural world in Europe from 1600 to the present, analyzing both how Europeans have altered their surroundings as well as how these environments have shaped the trajectory of their societies. We will examine human relationships with specific natural phenomena (air, water, forests, disease, etc.), as well as various themes of European history through an environmental lens (e.g., imperialism, industrialization, war, capitalism & communism, etc.). This course is ultimately an overview of key themes and developments in Europe's environmental history, told in part through select case studies. The aim is to provide an analysis of important environmental developments across the continent, from the Iberian Peninsula to European Russia, but there will be many stones left unturned. Students will, however, have opportunities to explore topics and areas of interest in addition to the required reading material. Many of the ideas and arguments we will explore have direct applications to the broader environmental history of the planet, some of which will be explored from a comparative perspective.

**MIN 203: Climate Change: Knowledge Empowers Action. Frey, H. and Wang, J.** Climate change is arguably one of the most pressing issues in modern society, with potential for global disruption and destabilization. This course will provide foundational knowledge about climate change from multiple perspectives, including faculty, alumni, and climate entrepreneurs and activists, to empower students to educate and advocate for change. We need to understand the science of climate change - what causes it and how do we know? What are natural climate patterns and how have humans affected them? We need to understand how to measure and quantify climate change and climate-related risks. How do we interpret data and project various possible futures? How do we construct and assess climate models and

address uncertainties? Finally, we need to understand the ramifications of climate change on our planet and humankind. What strategies can we adopt, as individuals and as a society, to mitigate the effects of climate change? What are the socio-political and economic implications of various policies? Our ultimate goal in this course is for you to understand climate change and how the actions of individuals and groups can make a difference. Working in teams, you will design a project to teach others about climate change, and invent or campaign for something that will make a positive impact in your community. Pre-requisites: None. SET, QMR, SOCS

**MIN-206: Sustainable Living Practices. C. Henseler.** If you want to be part of the solution, be part of this class. Pledge to change your habits and develop a project of your choice to implement on campus or in your community. In this class you will read articles, watch TEDTalks and documentaries, and examine the impact of what you eat, wear, and consume, how you live, travel, and even think about your future careers. You will research impact studies, explore companies and innovators that do good, communicate with friends and family, and design a sustainability project of your choice. In this class you will increase your own awareness of how to live a more sustainable life and you will also take action and have a direct impact on our world by writing, pitching, and potentially publishing an Op-Ed. Pre-requisites: None. GenEd: HUM, WAC

**MIN 213: Sex and Power. Mitchell, J. and Scheiter, K.** Gender inequity is a problem that affects every single one of us. It is estimated, for example, that gender inequity costs the United States around 2 trillion dollars in lost GDP. Gender bias in healthcare means that women's pain is often taken less seriously than men's pain, leading to misdiagnosis and inadequate care. The United States has the highest maternal mortality rate of any developed country and non-Hispanic Black women are three times more likely to die than White women as the result of childbirth. Women continue to be underrepresented in politics, film, STEM, Fortune 500 companies, Silicon Valley, and almost everywhere important decisions are being made. Recent studies also suggest that men's health and life expectancy is worse in countries with greater inequality. Thus, gender inequity is both the cause and the effect of discrimination, oppression, and abuse. In this class we will pose intersectional questions about the relationship between gender, sex, and power and ask students to engage with the broader social, cultural, and political implications of institutional misogyny and other forms of discrimination. Throughout our term together, we will consider big picture questions related to women in politics, gender and the economy, sexual equity, women's movements, transphobia, popular culture, and much more. The course will culminate in student-led projects that identify a specific, possibly local, gender-based problem and envision and articulate possible solutions. The course will include interdisciplinary guest lecturers, workshops, student-led discussions, and invited speakers. Some events will take place outside of the class. Students are expected to attend as many of these events as possible. Pre-requisites: None. HUM, SOCS.

**MTH-065: Mathematics and Social Justice. Staff.** Though issues of equity and fairness are not new to mathematics, in recent years mathematicians have been forced to confront and reckon with the impacts of their work on society in profound new ways. Indeed, mathematicians are designing algorithms to be used for predictive policing, testifying in Supreme Court cases regarding political redistricting, and modeling the disproportionate impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on communities of color. How can (and should) mathematics play a vital role in upholding the essential tenets of social justice, such as equity, diversity and racial justice, access and participation, and human rights? The fundamental mathematical topics we will consider are selected from (but are not limited to!) the following major subject areas: systems of linear equations; mathematical modeling; probability and statistics; graph theory; voting/social choice theory; and gerrymandering. We will approach our study of the mathematical concepts in this course through the lens of social justice. GEN ED, QMR.

**MTH 105 Differential Calculus with Precalculus. Staff.** Differential calculus of functions of a single variable, supplemented with supporting precalculus. Limits, continuity, differentiation, and applications. QMR

**PSC 250: Politics of Resistance. Ahmed, S.** Nation-state systems often create ingroups and outgroups along other power relations of class, race, and gender. As a result, movements of resistance emerge. These movements may be legal or illegal, pacifist or armed, popular or isolated, but in all cases, they point to consistent contradictions within the system of nation-states. In this course, we will explore various ongoing resistance movements from different political

and geographic contexts. Our case studies will include Maoist, anarchist, feminist, and indigenous movements from Asia, Africa, and the Americas. Through our discussions of these movements, we will analyze and compare their philosophies, politics, and strategies. In most cases, the states these movements oppose have either banned them or sought to squash them through force. Because of this, there are few balanced sources about these movements, and we will thus also explore how power and knowledge production are used to sideline opposition forces.

**PSY 238: Power and Group Dynamics. O'Dea, C.** Society is structured in hierarchies. These hierarchies are created on several different factors: merit, race, gender, sexual orientation, religion, etc. While the legitimacy of these hierarchies is heavily debated in public discourse, on social media, and in other platforms, there is little consensus about the merits/issues/disadvantages of social hierarchy. In a general sense, people who value social hierarchies impress the viewpoint that groups and individuals at the top earned their way to the top via hard work and merit while groups and individuals at the bottom are there because they did not do the right things or make the right choices. In this course, students will research power and group dynamics to better understand ways that different social groups have gained, lost, or fight to reinforce their position in the status hierarchy. Prerequisite: PSY 100

**REL 250: Death and Afterlife in World Religions. Bedford, P.** This course investigates how various religions (Judaism, Christianity, Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism, Daoism, and examples of indigenous and ancient religions) understand death and the afterlife, and how this understanding relates to views of the human person. The course also discusses religious rituals pertaining to death, near death experiences, the undead, and contemporary practices such as public memorialization. Our study of death and the afterlife draws on a variety of methods: history, anthropology, sociology, philosophy. Pre-requisites: None. LCC, HUM

**SPN 420: Hunger and Money: Narratives of Economic Crisis in Spain Today. Collinge, D.** Hunger, money, crisis, resistance, revolution. A mother moves to a different country in search of a job that will support her partner and infant son. Machine arms snake out of the sky, threatening to snatch up unwary citizens. A community travels the streets of Barcelona in search of scrap metal, making a future from the waste of the past. A bomb goes off and flames rise up in a city flooded with protesters. These characters and landscapes are only a few of those we will get to know in this class, which investigates the state of the economy and politics in Spain, through short stories, graphic novels, films, and economic and political theory. We will study notions of crisis, debt, and income inequality as they pertain to workers, politicians, banks, and the government. This combination of cultural and theoretical materials will allow us to explore the consequences of dominant economic practices while examining alternative political spaces. **Pre-requisites:** SPN 203 and two 300-level Spanish courses, or permission of the instructor. **Common Curriculum credit:** LCC, HUM/HUL, WAC.
