Courses numbered 200-299 are those at the sophomore/junior level that may also be taken by non-majors. Courses numbered 300-399 are upper-level that are primarily intended for majors, i.e., which represent the depth component of the major. Courses numbered 400-499 are all advanced level courses for seniors, including those used to fulfill the Senior Writing Experience (WS), seminars, research, thesis and independent studies.

## DESCRIPTION OF COURSES NOT IN THE 2020-21 ACADEMIC REGISTER

**\*Includes Revised Course Descriptions\***

**AAH-225: Art in Ritual Context. Lullo, S.** This course aims to explore and restore the use-contexts, performative spaces and architectural frameworks that are frequently lost when works of visual culture are hung on museum walls or placed within a glass case. We will read about art historical and anthropological approaches to art and ritual and analyze case studies of the ways in which ritual practice, both sacred and secular, can be integral to our understanding of how the works of art were created, used, viewed, and experienced across global contexts. Final projects in this course will focus on objects from Union's own Permanent Collection of artworks. **No pre-requisites. HUM, LCC**

**CLS-191: Ancient Engineering. Commito, A.** How did people of the ancient Mediterranean physically transform the world around them, and what do those transformations tell us about their values and beliefs? This course introduces students to the major engineering successes (and failures!) of the communities living around the Mediterranean Sea and in southwest Asia. We explore well-known case studies – such as Egyptian pyramids, Assyrian siege engines, Persian *qanat* systems, Greek temples, and Roman aqueducts – as well as the humbler aspects of daily life, such as houses, sewers, and water pumps. We examine multiple forms of evidence, including archaeology, visual imagery, literature, inscriptions, ethnography, re-enactment, and modelling. Along the way, we reflect on how ancient developments in engineering have shaped our lives today. **No pre-requisites. HUM.**

**ECO-312: Seminar in Economics & Financial Forecasting. Karadas, Ercan.** The increasing complexity and the uncertainty of global markets is fueling the demand for professional experts who possess a good understanding of statistical tools to solve forecasting problems, and necessary computer skills to create relevant forecasts. Therefore, a proper understanding and training in time series analysis and forecasting is a highly valuable asset. This class combines the essential tools in economics, statistics, and programming to meet these growing needs. In particular, students will be taught the formal procedures of identifying and understanding characteristics of time series and financial data, and the skills for developing and analyzing models for forecasting time series data. Furthermore, we will discuss "real-world" applications for modeling and evaluating forecasts upon which decision-making would depend. Substantial emphasis will also be placed on efficient and effective use of R programming language and all assignments will require extensive use of R. (Prerequisites: ECO 101, ECO 243) Common Curriculum: WAC.

**ECO-320: Political Economy of Development in Asia. Dang, Huong.** Have you ever been fascinated by the phenomenal growth rates of Asian countries such as Singapore, Japan and South Korea in the last few decades? Would you like to find out the underlying mechanisms of their success stories? How could less developed countries use the lessons from these cases to catch up with the rest of the world? What are the major development challenges that are particular to Asia and how to overcome them? This course will help you approach the answers to these questions by first equipping you with the theoretical framework and econometric tools that guide your exploration and evaluation of relevant scholarly research. Then, we will examine the development experience of Asia through various case studies with a focus on their political economy aspects. The course will culminate in a major individual research project that you will undertake for a substantial portion of your final grade. (Prerequisites: ECO 241, ECO 242, ECO 243) Common Curriculum: WAC. Interdisciplinary Programs: AS

**ECO-373: Seminar in Environmental Economics, Abraham, Caroline.** This course will introduce several advanced topics in environmental economics. We shall consider the question: how do economists value goods that have no readily available monetary value, such as clean air or a biodiverse forest? We shall study tools used to answer this question, as well as ways of evaluating environmental programs and policies that are already put in place. I will start with an overview of the background material required to engage with the material in this course by covering some basic concepts in environmental economics. We shall spend time developing commonly used tools in environmental economics such as hedonic pricing methods, contingent valuation surveys, quasi-experimental program evaluation as

well as an overview of cost-benefit analysis. I will do an overview of econometric techniques where appropriate. You will be required to develop a research topic using the tools discussed in class. The goal of this course is to teach techniques necessary to do analysis in environmental economics as well as familiarizing you with this literature. (Prerequisites: ECO 241 and ECO 243)

**HST-164: Western Imperialism in the Long 19<sup>th</sup> Century, c. 1815 – 1939. Charnley, N.** This course surveys the social, political, economic, cultural, and intellectual history of imperialism in Europe and the world from the mid-nineteenth to mid-twentieth centuries. Throughout history, geopolitical imperial rivalries between European nation-states across the world provided the political and cultural environments in which a diverse array of people made impactful connections. In various forms, imperialism has proven to be a durable political system within which various peoples struggle for political representation, civic rights, citizenship, and cultural identity. Amid these struggles, individual people and various groups used labels such as nationality, race, gender, and culture as means of inclusion and exclusion, in the process defining, challenging, and redefining both their meanings and membership. This course examines the global phenomenon of imperialism in the modern era and how, in its various forms, it dictated the terms on which change took place. **SOCS.**

**LAT-250: Roman Epigraphy: An Introduction to Latin Inscriptions. Mueller, H.-F.** In this course, we shall read & study inscriptions in Latin that have survived thousands of years on stone as well as on a variety of other surfaces. The study of such documents has a name — “epigraphy” — a word whose roots literally mean “writing on” [i.e., the act of writing on some object]. We shall read a selection of these documents in Latin, learn about the cultural history of why Romans wrote on stone and what they wrote about as well as the organization of these documents in such collections as the *Corpus Inscriptionum Latinarum (Collection of Latin Inscriptions)* and the on-line *Epigraphic Database*. We shall, of course, also pay attention to Latin grammar and syntax, and learn to use inscriptions for finding answers to historical questions that literary authors often ignore. Students will translate texts, prepare occasional short reports, and write a term paper on a topic chosen in consultation with the instructor. Short, but frequent, exercises (including journals), will allow students to document their progress along their individual epigraphical journeys. **Prerequisite: LAT 103 (or its equivalent) or permission of the instructor. HUM, WAC (pending approval).**

**MTH 105 Differential Calculus with Precalculus. Staff.** Differential calculus of functions of a single variable, supplemented with supporting precalculus. Limits, continuity, differentiation, and applications. **QMR**

**PHL 239/LAS-239: History of Latin American Philosophy. Cruz Tleugabulova, M.** This course will examine four of the most important figures from the history of Latin American philosophy: Bartolomé de las Casas, Sor Juana Inés de la Cruz, Simón Bolívar, and José Martí. They each engaged with the complex philosophical problems of their time, including: what are human rights, and why are they being denied to the indigenous people of the Americas? Why are women being denied a right to education? What political system should Latin Americans pursue, given their collective identity? What is the nature of that identity? Should Latin Americans try to imitate Anglo-Americans in any way? We will read, discuss, and write about their answers to these questions while keeping in view both their historical context and their lasting philosophical significance.

**PSC-215R: African Liberation Politics. McGill, L.** In this course, we will read a variety of remarkable texts written by African revolutionary thinkers whose works are extremely influential in terms of not only African studies but also politics of liberation and the idea of liberty as such. We will read works by Franz Fanon, Steve Biko, Walter Rodney, and Kwame Nkrumah among others, to learn about forms of political practice and thought that are centered around liberation. In addition to studying multiple works by African thinkers and on African liberation movements, the course aims to familiarize students with some key concepts in liberation politics such as “total liberation” per Fanon, “Black consciousness” per Biko, colonial “underdevelopment” per Rodney, and “Consciencism” per Nkrumah. Because of the vastness of African liberation politics, the course includes a relatively large number of required readings.

**SOC-232: Sociology of Sexualities. Franklin, K.** This course is an introduction to the study of sexualities and sexual identities. While sexuality is often believed to be a private, natural occurrence between individuals, in this course we will explore the ways in which sexualities and sexual identities are actually socially contracted phenomena. We will cover a variety of topics including (but not limited to): the ways in which sexualities intersect with other systems of

power including race, gender, and class; the way in which society uses sexualities to create borders and boundaries around right and wrong; and how certain social institutions such as the government and the media shape sexual identities. The goal of this course is to develop a personal understanding of the social construction of sexuality and how this perspective is critical for actively engaging in the deconstruction of heteronormative, racist, and classist identities and social structures in our society. By the end of the course each student will have the tools to critically examine the assumptions about sexuality that shape our lives. **Pre-requisites: SOC 100 or permission of the instructor.**
