Committee Report (SAC):

SAC Update

- One theme house review left.

- Meeting with Chris Hayden today, the list of over 30 things were brought forward and we only actually talked about 1. The only thing we talked about for the entire hour was the issue with the shooter conversation that was happening on campus. The actual shooting happened on Van Vranken at 4:37pm and when the interns were telling people at 6:30pm, they were only actually reviewing the footage and the black car was only on campus for 30 seconds. We talked about the inefficient conversation between students and campus safety. We talked about how they should communicate faster but Hayden told SAC that there is a line of communication they have to follow before blasting it to the campus.
- Blue lights: felt like the same conversation that was held last year. They ordered the wrong parts so they will be ordering the new parts. The blue light by Fox will probably be updated to have a camera since they are doing repairs down there right now.
 - (BH) They check the blue lights every month and while its true that the ones were down last year are fixed, some are still down.
- We are inviting them to come next week to talk about the rest of the list.
- Someone mentioned that the campus safety numbers that are on the back of the card get wiped away with overuse. They are working on adding a film to the back so the numbers won't wipe away.
- (AH) In preparation for that meeting, I sent out a google form with concerns to the Panhellenic community and over 70% of the respondents said that their frustration was with the student body and campus safety communication.
- (ZM) I think that the committee on campus safety should be used in order for students to help spread the word about
- (RP) We want to learn more about the minor committees and we want to know if committees are involved, what is actually happening on them and how do we get students involved.
- (ZM) Reaching out to actual campus safety would be helpful when reaching out to them about the focus on the committees so that way there can be discussion between the students and the people in the related departments.
- (SG) I also met with Campus Safety this week because we had parents call and complain to Campus Safety after we had a meeting with them at SDT. They aren't necessarily doing anything wrong, they just need to focus on student and campus safety relations.
 - It is all on Chris Hayden really because the officers are just being told what to do.
- (CB) A lot of the distrust comes from when issues aren't being reported and maybe if they are
 - (SG) They have an anonymous report form on their website.
- (EC) Would there be a way that we could bring Chris in to Student Forum so that we can help them come up with a plan to help them get
 - (MS) We are thinking about doing another Student Forum retreat for the winter and I would encourage all of you to come up with an initiative in a specific department. Continue to follow the passions that you have and continue this conversation as we go into the winter term.
- (EC) The reason why they were not informed about the shooter was being it was so far away from campus and there was not imminent threat to the campus, which is what I heard.
