

DIRECTORS' NOTE

Thank you for joining us for *At the Intersection*— an evening of original dances choreographed by students and faculty. As dancemakers and embodied scholars, we believe in the power of dance to explore our intersectional identities, cultural connections, values, and passions. Engaging in the process of creating new dances is an artistic practice that requires problem-solving, communication, collaboration AND innovation. This year's Winter Dance Concert features the culmination of choreographic research by six senior dance minors enrolled in the *ADA 350: Group Choreography* course and their casts of peers, as well as student performers enrolled in our faculty-led choreography practicums, plus members of the Union College Academy for Lifelong Learning (UCALL).

The dynamic collaboration between UCALL's Val D'Amario and the Dance Program began in Spring 2022. Students ages 55+ are invited to participate in a weekly dance class in the Henle Studio, taught by dance movement specialist, Maxine Lautenberg. For *At the Intersection*, Maxine and Laurie co-created *Visibilis*- a work addressing questions of community, visibility, biases, and support, performed by Union Dance students alongside the UCALL students. Engaging these two unlikely groups, representing a life span from 18 to 86, creates meaningful intersections for each artist. A work that could not exist fully without the other. In the words of Joan Mikalson, UCALL performer: "We are truly grateful for this rare opportunity – this sense of purpose and belonging, the essence of lifelong learning".

The other works on the program grapple with topics ranging from understanding the human mind and our relationships with others; exploring dream states, celestial beings, and the passage of time; from challenging gender norms and systems of oppression, to pursuing an aesthetic of joy. It has been an absolute pleasure to see how all the choreographers and performers have grown through this journey. And we are grateful to our professional colleagues, who met with each choreographer to create original costume and lighting designs for each piece!

Another highlight of this performance is the opportunity to choreograph to the music of several local musicians: Connor Armbruster (Troy, NY), Andy Iorio (Ballston Spa, NY) and Union student, Darren Nguyen ('25). In addition, works from this concert will be adapted for a student touring ensemble for our upcoming performances at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival in August 2023.
